PERMISSION TO SHOOT APPROVAL OF PARENT/GUARDIAN(S)

New York State Law requires that in order for campers to participate in the rifle or shotgun areas, they must be at least 12 years old. In order to participate in the pistol area, they must be at least 14 years of age and registered in either the Venturing or Sea Scouting program. All individuals under the age of 18 who wish to participate in any of the shooting sports affiliated with a Seneca Waterways Council unit **MUST** have this permission to shoot form completed by their parent(s) or guardian(s) in order for their scout to participate in any of these activities.

All activities will be done in compliance with the BSA National Shooting Sports Manual, The Guide to Safe Scouting and all applicable New York State and Federal laws and regulations.
