2024 Seneca Waterways Council Paperwork Checklist (Staff and Participants)

Many parents choose to bring copies of the required paperwork (see <u>this document</u> for a complete list and more info) to the SPIN meeting that occurs in June, others prefer to scan and email them to <u>nylt@senecawaterways.org</u>.

Either way, there are often a number of small (and large) errors and omissions, and these create extra work to correct.

Let's eliminate those errors and omissions up front!!!

Here's a checklist for each form. If you check all the boxes, we can do a "one touch" with your Scout's paperwork!

1) Provide COPIES, not originals		
		All copies are completely legible
		The entire page is visible on all copies
1)	BSA Health and Medical Records (HaMR)	
		Parts A, B1, B2 and C are all provided
		A copy of the front AND back of the Health Insurance Card that covers the Scout is provided
		Part A – The Scout and a parent have signed and dated this page
		Part A – All adults (including parents) that are permitted to drive the Scout to and pick up from NYLT are listed
		Part A - Adults that are NOT permitted (if any) to pick up the Scout are also listed on Part A
		Part B1 – every space at the top of the form is filled out
		Part B1 – The Health History is completely filled out (even if you are providing a copy of your Scout's physical report)
		Part B2 – it is CRITICAL that all allergies are listed here
		Part B2 – the Summer Camp Medication Permission Form (SCMPF) supersedes the Medication section on Part B2, so you do not need to duplicate that info here
		Part B2 – Most parents provide a copy of their Scout's physician report for vaccinations, but PLEASE LIST the DATE on B2 for <u>Tetanus</u>
		Part C – The Scout's physician must fill this out <u>COMPLETELY</u> , and SIGN and DATE this section. Stamped <u>signatures</u> are acceptable, but a SIGNATURE and DATE must be on this form
		Part C – The date of the physician's signature MUST BE more recent than August 3, 2023 (BSA HaMR are valid for one year)
2)	2) Summer Camp Medication Permission Form (SCMPF)	
		If the Scout will be taking ANY medications at NYLT, this form is completely filled out, signed and DATED by the Scout's physician
		Even if the Scout is not taking any medications at NYLT, the parent must fill out, sign and date this form
3)	Food Ir	nformation Form (FIF)
		A Food Information Form is required for ALL NYLT Staff and Participants
		A parent must fill out, sign and date the FIF
		Explicit information is provided on the FIF so that we can accommodate your Scout's needs
