ABC Medical Forms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A pre-participation physical is needed to complete part C, a physical is good for one year • The physical & part C need to be completed by a certified and licensed physician (MD, DO), nurse practitioner, or physician assistant. • Ensure form has all required <u>Signatures</u> • "Tetanus immunization is required and must have been received within the last 10 years" 	
Youth Medication Permission Form: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only for Youth • Ensure form has all required <u>Signatures</u> 	
Meningococcal Meningitis Vaccination Form: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only for Youth 	
Participants Immunization record: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highlight the Tetanus shot on record 	
Copy of participants insurance card	
Youth Protection Training certificates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only For Adults 	
Printout of the unit's official roster <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Including both adult and youth registrants. • Please Highlight all participants • <u>Roster will be printed from my.scouting.org or obtained from your Scout Service Center</u> • All participants must be registered members of BSA, especially adults 	
Pre-Swim Check: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Necessary if your itinerary has participants in or on a body of water • Pre-swim check for all participants • All participants must pass the "BSA Swimmer's test"
