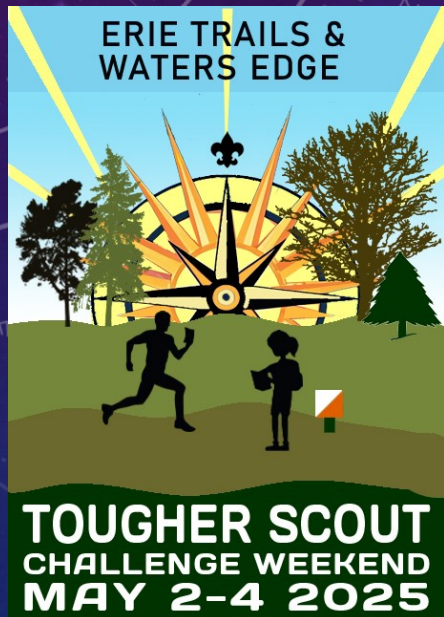

PURPOSE

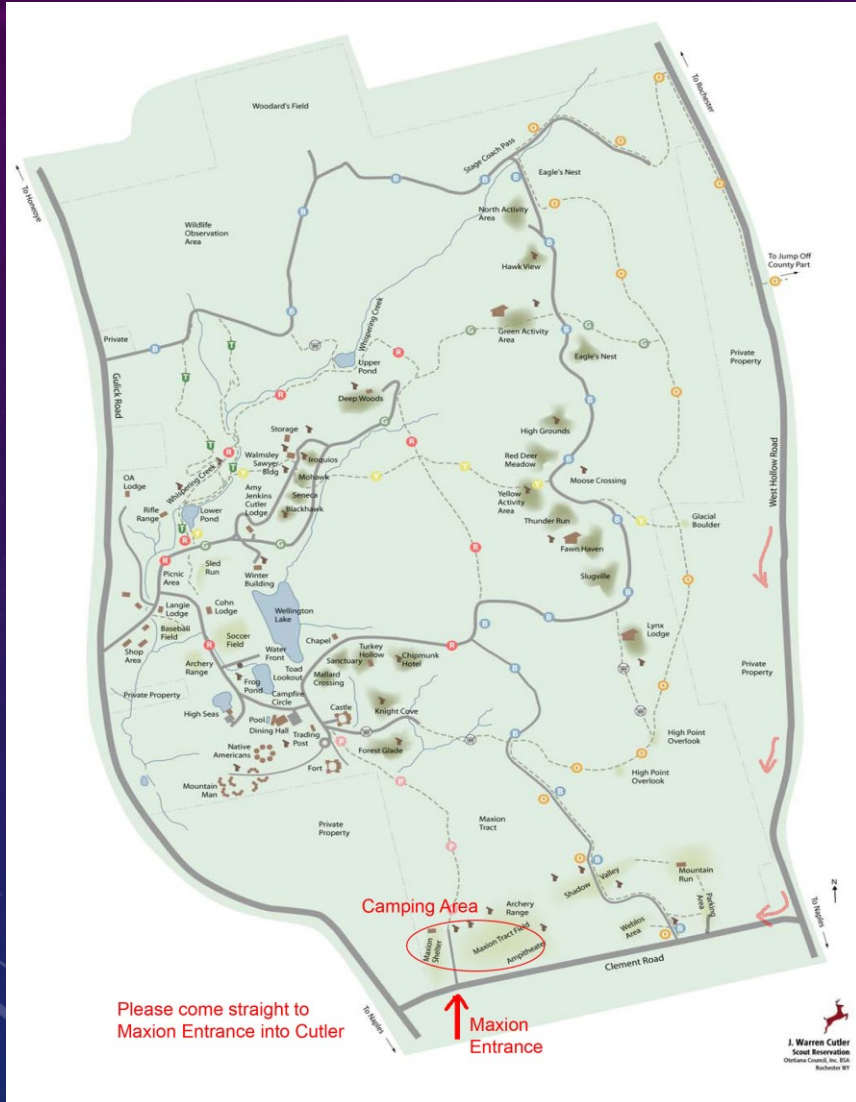
- Provide patrol-based challenges...
