



Eagle Flight 2020

Eagle Flight is specifically designed for the older Scouts to give them the opportunity to work on the merit badges they need to progress along their Trail-to-Eagle! Eagle Flight is not a typical BSA summer camp program. This highly structured program offers more than 40 merit badges along with many exciting non-merit badge programs and activities specifically designed for the Eagle Candidates. Join fellow Eagle Candidates for this very special one week event where Eagles soar!

- Only program of its kind offered in the BSA's Northeast region and in its eleventh year.
- Enjoy Camp Babcock-Hovey without the throngs of younger Scouts.
- Participants must be at least 14 years old and First Class by the first day of Eagle Flight Camp.
- Open to female Scouts, including those on Eagle Scout rank extensions.
- Arrangements can be made to help Scouts finish previous partials. (Ask how!)
- Limited to 50 Eagle Candidates so hurry and sign up today for your spot in this popular camp!

Organization: During the week at camp, Scouts are divided into troops. A SPL, ASPL and patrol leaders are elected for each troop. They will run the troop during the week, along with adult leadership from experienced Eagle Scouts and Scouters.

Eagle Flight Prerequisites Meetings: Eagle Flight Week actually begins with monthly meetings which are the third Wednesday of each month beginning in February 2020 where Scouts can begin preparing for their 90-day Eagle-required merit badges, meet their assigned Troop Scoutmaster and merit badge counselors. This enables Scouts to arrive at camp with their prerequisites completed and have the appropriate evidence needed so their merit badges can be completed while at camp. Registration: Registration for Eagle Flight is a quick two-step process:

1. Online Registration at (<http://scoutingevent.com/397-eagleflight>) where information is collected and payment is made. A \$100 deposit is required at the time of registration online. (BSA Member ID is needed for the online registration process.)
2. Paper form with the appropriate parent/guardian signature and unit leader recommendation, then sent to the Scout Service Center.

Cost: Regular registration fee is 475 for the program if paid by April 15, 2020
Late registration is \$525 for payments mad in full after April 16th, 2020

A \$25 rebate will be provided to a family whose Scout attends a summer session of Seneca Waterways Council camp during the same year as their Eagle Flight attendance. Families must request the rebate using an online request form available after summer camps close in August.
