

Scoutmasters,

Greetings from Wehinahpay Mountain Camp! Summer Camp 2024 is almost here! My name is Scott Schmitz, your Camp Commissioner for 2024. I wanted to take a moment to thank you and all the adults coming to WMC. As a former Scoutmaster I know the hard work all of you have put in to prepare for summer camp and would like to give some insight on what to expect when you arrive.

ARRIVAL

Check-in begins at 1:00 pm MDT and goes to 4:30pm MDT. If you plan on arriving earlier, please contact our *Camp Director Michael Beaumont Michael.beaumont@scouting.org.* When you arrive at WMC you will be greeted by our parking lot crew who will instruct your troop where/how to park your vehicles. Per our fire evacuation plan, all vehicles will be backed into rows to facilitate a quicker exit if needed. Your Troop Guide will contact you, introduce themselves, and give instructions for unloading. At least one adult from your troop will proceed to the porch of the parking lot to complete check-in. The troop will off load their gear to facilitate moving into their campsites.

Adults checking in, please bring all paperwork to include all med forms in a three-ring binder, all prescription medication to be reviewed by our medic, medication log, shooting sports waivers, Hazardous Weather Training Certificate (minimum one adult), YPT certificates, and payment for any outstanding balance.

TRAILERS

Trailers will be parked separate from their tow vehicles per fire evacuation procedures. The *Camp Ranger, Brian Chambers*, has complete authority and <u>final word</u> on deciding what trailers can be taken to/left at campsites. Camp roads to campsites will NOT accommodate any double axle trailers. The Camp Ranger will decide if your single axle trailer can be allowed in your campsite. Please pack your trailers in anticipation of offloading in the parking lot to designated WMC trailers driven by staff that will deliver your gear to your campsite. PRO TIP: Have tarps available to cover your gear.

TENT ASSIGNMENTS

Please determine your tent assignments by age, sex, youth, and adult. Send a list of how many tents your troop needs one week before you arrive to our *Camp Ranger <u>brian.chambers@scouting.org</u>*. Camp Assignments will be assigned upon arrival based on troop size.
