Objective: Assists the Camp Ranger with the overall operation and maintenance of the physical camp facilities and equipment in accordance with the standards set by the Boy Scouts of America and the Northern Lights Council.

Essential Functions: Must be at least 21 years old .This person must also have completed Youth Protection training, Youth on Youth Abuse Training, First Aid training, CPR/AED training, and Planning and Preparing for Hazardous Weather training.

Specific Responsibilities:

Works closely with the Camp Ranger to ensure the facilities and equipment are in working order and clean for the campers and staff. Specific responsibilities include:

- Check in daily with Camp Ranger for assignments.
- Inspect camp daily to identify facility, equipment, or inventory needs.
- Be particularly alert to conditions that affect health, safety, sanitation, and good housekeeping practices.
- Be knowledgeable in, and ready to implement all camp emergency procedures.
- Other duties as assigned by Camp Ranger.
