## 2024 Itinerary

Note: All times are Mountain

### Arrival Day

- Upon arrival in Medora, go immediately to the **Medora Campground Office**. The Medora Campground is located on the west side of town, across the Little Missouri River. The staff at the campground office will review the itinerary and contents of your packet and check you into your group tent site.
- **5:45pm** – Please report to the **Harold Schafer Heritage Center** for the flag lowering ceremony at 6:00pm. A volunteer will be there to meet you to assist with flags and show you the ropes for future flag ceremonies. After this ceremony, your group will walk to the entrance of Theodores to begin the Town Square Ceremony. After the flags are lowered a Volunteer will show you where to place the flags for storage overnight. Tom Brosseau who will be playing the Great American Folk Show on the Town Square Patio would like to introduce the troops before doing the flags at the Townsquare Patio. Please connect with him and wait for his cue before doing the flag ceremony. (There is a plastic bin labeled 'Flags', in the store room between the bathrooms on the patio of the town square. This room remains unlocked at all times) **After this time, all Flag ceremonies will be lead only by your troop.**
- **6:45pm**- Activities as designated by the troop leaders

### Second Day

- **8:15am** – Please report to the **Town Square** for the flag raising ceremony at 8:30am.
- **9:30am** – Please report to **Mini Golf**. A staff person will meet your group and provide instructions to assist with cleanup of the mini golf greens and surrounding area. (1 hour)
- **10:30am** – Help with Medora Recycling Program (if needed) picking up recyclables from places around town.
- **1:00pm** – Please report to the **Medora Campground Office**. A staff member will provide instructions and needed items to clean up the campground area. (1 to 2 hours)
- **3:00pm** – Activities designated by the troop leaders.
- **5:45pm** – Please report to the **Harold Schafer Heritage Center** for the flag lowering ceremony at 5:45pm. Followed by the flag lowering in ceremony at the Town Square at 6:00pm. Tom Brosseau who will be playing the Great American Folk Show on the Town Square Patio would like to introduce the troops before doing the flags at the

Townsquare Patio. Please connect with him and wait for his cue before doing the flag ceremony.

- **6:45pm** – Activities as designated by the troop leaders.

*\*if additional tickets are needed to be purchased, please stop by the campground office.*

## Third Day

- **8:15am** – Please report to the **Town Square** for the flag raising ceremony at 8:30am. (Please pick-up Flags from the bins in the store room, located between the bathrooms on the Town Square Patio.)
- **9:30am** – Please report to the **Burning Hills Amphitheatre** by the top of the escalator. A staff member will meet your group and provide instructions to assist with cleanup of the theater and the surrounding area. (1-1 ½ hours)
- **1:00pm** – Please report to the **Medora Campground Office** for cleanup of the campground area. (1-2 hours)
- **3:00pm** – Activities as designated by the troop leaders.
- **5:30pm** – **Pitchfork Fondue**. Enjoy a Fondue Steak with all the fixins' at the beautiful Tjaden Terrace.
- **7:30pm**– **Medora Musical** performed in the spectacular Burning Hills Amphitheatre.

## Day of Departure

- **8:15am** – Please report to the **Town Square** for the flag raising ceremony at 8:30am
