## FISHING AREA UPGRADES & DOCK REPLACEMENT

The **Fishing Area** is home of camp's largest and most heavily utilized fishing pier, which is in very poor shape and questionable year to year. This includes a "boathouse" building erected in 1947, which was built to store boats but is also heavily utilized as the indoor home for the fishing program. Our goal for this project is **\$190,000**.

The building was constructed with storage in mind, so the interior is partially finished. About half the building floor is dirt/gravel and a large portion of the siding is in disrepair and needs replacement. The roof was replaced with a metal roof a few years ago, but needs to be "shored up". There is a large, commercial boat dock to stage motor boats and pontoons that is currently in good repair.

### USAGE BACKGROUND

- Site for delivering fishing related merit badges and programs, such as fishing, fly fishing, and motorboating.
- Pier is open for all Scouts to use.
- Potential to expand the scope of the fishing program.

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Replace pier with Polydock configuration
- Building Renovation
  - Complete the concrete flooring of building
  - Replace all siding
  - Replace current door with a garage style, overhead door
  - Replace windows
  - Add service door

### COST ESTIMATE

- Fishing Pier: **\$100,000**
- Boathouse remodel: **\$90,000+** (if scope is expanded)

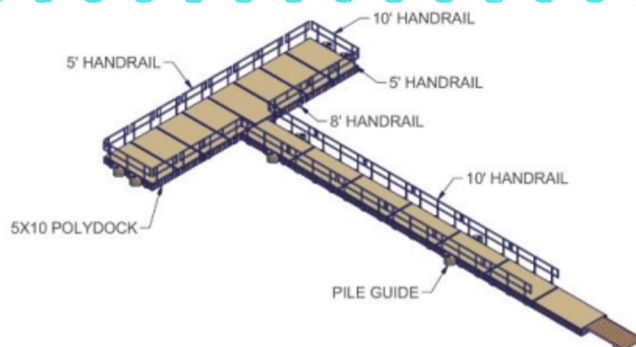
