

# 2027 SCUBA HIGH ADVENTURE TRIP

Roatan, Honduras | June 19-26, 2027  
Participant Cost: **\$2,950** (flights not included)

## TRIP OVERVIEW

This seven-night all-inclusive dive package includes daily boat dives, specialty workshops, shore diving access, and multiple island activities. Participants also receive two night dives, a buoyancy workshop, a day trip to Maya Key, and an Island Fiesta night. We will fly to Roatan on Saturday, June 19 and fly home on Saturday, June 26.

## WHAT'S INCLUDED

- 7-night accommodation with full meal plan
- Daily diving (3 boat dives/day for 6 days), 2 night dives, workshop, and shore diving
- Tanks, weight belts, and weights
- Airport transfers, welcome beverage, and flight reconfirmation
- Museum admission, kayaking/paddleboarding, Maya Key excursion, and fiesta
- High adventure t-shirt and patch

## OPTIONAL ADD-ON EXCURSION (\$80)

**Zipline at Gumbalimba Park:** Experience a 13-traverse canopy tour over Roatan's mountain range, ending at the beach in Gumbalimba Park. Includes a safety briefing, platforms up to 60 feet high, and scenic coastal views. Closed-toe shoes required. Shorts or long pants recommended. Note that a rider weight limit applies.

- PADI Advanced Open Water Certification: **\$150** through Mick's Scuba (Moorhead)
- PADI Specialties (Deep, Digital Photo, Video, Boat, Fish ID, Nitrox): **\$150 each**

## PAYMENTS AND DUE DATES

- **\$500 deposit** due at registration (**non-refundable**) with four quarterly payments of **\$612.50**
  - \$1,112.50 due September 1, 2026
  - \$1,725.00 due December 1, 2026
  - \$2,337.50 due March 1, 2027
  - Final balance of **\$2,950** due June 1, 2027

## CANCELLATION POLICY

- All fees are **non-refundable** but are **transferable** to another Scout or adult.
- Once a deposit is submitted, participants commit to all scheduled payments.
- **No refunds will be issued for any reason!**

- Confined water classes are offered on the second weekend of each month.
- Open-water certification dives are offered three weekends per month in June through September, with some in May.
- It is recommended to get certified in 2026 for warmer water.

## PASSPORTS AND TRAVEL RELEASE FORM

A valid U.S. passport is required for travel to Honduras. Passport cards are not valid for international air travel. We recommend that you apply early as processing may take 6+ weeks.

A travel release must be signed by all guardians of any youth traveling internationally. If one parent is attending the trip, the other must still sign the release. Forms are available on the registration site.

## CLIMATE INFORMATION (JUNE)

- Approx. water temperature: **84° F**
- Approx. air temperature: **86° F**
- Recommended exposure protection: **Skin or shorty wetsuit**

## PACKING LIST

### Clothing

- 2 swimsuits – You'll wear one almost all day; rotate so one can dry while you use the other.
- 2 towels – One for saltwater, one for freshwater; consider making one a quick-dry pack towel.
- 2 casual outfits – Light dresses or shorts/shirts for downtime or meals.
- 1 pair of ankle socks – Helps prevent fins from rubbing your heels.

### Toiletries

- Deodorant – It gets hot, especially on the sundeck.
- Hair ties – Keeps long hair from tangling in your mask.
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Hairbrush or comb – Saltwater makes hair harder to manage.
- Lotion – Saltwater is drying.
- Eye drops – Useful if your eyes are sensitive to salt.
- Contacts/glasses – Bring extra contacts; prescription masks are available for rent if you wear glasses.

### Protection from the Elements

- Hat – Preferably one that covers your ears.
- Motion-sickness tablets – The boat ride can be choppy.
- Sunscreen (SPF 30+) – You can still burn even with limited surface time.
- Sunglasses – One pair is usually enough.

### Gear

- Dive log – For recording dives.
- Certification card
- Personal dive gear – Mask, fins, and snorkel required.
- Optional rentals include BC, wetsuit, dive computer, regulator set, and dive light.

### Other Items

- Money – For snacks or souvenirs.
- Snacks – Good to have between dives.
- Book – Paperbacks are easy to swap with other divers.
- Journal – For notes, memories, and new contacts.

## SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS

- **Key Superior Bungalows at Anthony's Key Resort:** Waterfront wooden bungalows located along the key's perimeter. Units feature polished wood interiors, Honduran-crafted furnishings, and large windows with ocean or partial-ocean views. Some are nestled within mangroves for added privacy. Most bungalows share a covered deck; two units are stand-alone and fully private. Access is by on-demand taxi boat.
- **Room Features:** The 256 ft<sup>2</sup> Key Superior Bungalows accommodate up to four guests and include either two double beds or one king bed. Each room has AC, equipped with a ceiling fan, in-room safe, mini-refrigerator, coffee maker, high-speed Wi-Fi, and daily housekeeping.

- **Bathroom:** Features a hot shower, hair dryer, and standard bath amenities.
- **Outdoor Space:** Each bungalow offers a covered deck with a hammock and patio dining set.
- **View & Policies:** Most units have ocean views, though some may be partially obscured by mangroves. All rooms are non-smoking.
