PARKING

Parking is available on the **north** side and **east** side of the Stern Cultural Center, as well as north of Old Main (#1) and Horton Hall (#2). No parking passes are required, as ticketing will be suspended that day. See the map on the registration site for details.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

All Scouts must pre-register for their classes using the online registration system. Depending on availability and scheduling, Scouts may register for either one or two classes. Some classes run only in the morning or afternoon, while others last all day. Walk-in registrations **will not** be accepted. Registration closes at the end of the day on Saturday, April 4. Please make sure all families in your troop are aware of this, as we cannot accommodate any registrations after this date.

PAYMENTS

All Scouts must pay their fees online before their class schedule is booked. The cost to attend is **\$25** for youth and **\$20** for adults, which covers patches, program supplies, and meals at the dining center. To help with planning, a **\$5 late fee** will be added to any sign-ups received after March 1. Scouts who register before March 1 are guaranteed a patch at the event, while those who register later may receive their patch by mail after the event.
