Stations:

1. Bigfoot Challenges (Sanders Pavilion)
2. Johnny Apple Seed (Pinecone Bird Feeders at Training Lodge Shelter/Pavilion)
3. Totem Pole (Balancing Platform in front of Dining Hall)
4. Cave Men (Fire Building/Fire Starters at Fire Ring behind Handi-Craft Shelter)
5. Old Lore Ravine (Ravine Crossing in woods across from Admin Building)
6. Oregon Trail (Obstacle Course)

Snacks and hot chocolate will be served in the Eagle Lodge at any time during the event.

Check In Starts at 12:00pm in the Eagle Lodge. Opening will start at 12:30pm.

Any units wanting to camp for the event, must follow and schedule with camp itself, freeze out committee nor District manages or coordinates that additional need.
