This Document pertains to anyone who registered their Troop for a session of Camp at Camp Friedlander in 2026. It is long, but it has a lot of useful information, so please read until the end!

I wanted to share a friendly reminder that **early pricing for individual registrations ends on December 31st** for all **overnight Summer Camp sessions at Camp Friedlander**.

To qualify for the early pricing rate, the **minimum per-person deposit must be submitted by December 31st**. For youth, the minimum initial deposit is \$75 and for adults it is \$55.

The current youth pricing schedule is as follows:

- **\$500** through **December 31, 2025** (early rate)
- **\$525** beginning **January 1, 2026** (regular rate)
- **\$540** beginning **May 1, 2026** (late rate)

Adult registrations are **\$155 through December 31**, increasing to **\$175 after December 31**, with no late rate.

Day campers do not have an Early Bird rate. The fee is **\$230**, with a **late rate of \$245 beginning May 1, 2026**.

Below are instructions for confirming participant numbers, submitting at least the minimum deposit, and entering participant details.

Adding Individual Deposits

The individual who created the troop’s initial camp reservation should have received a confirmation email that includes participant estimates. To add deposits:

1. Follow the link in the confirmation email.
2. Click **“Confirm Participants.”**
3. Select whether you would like to pay the minimum per-person deposit or a higher amount.
4. Click **“Checkout.”**

5. After checkout, you will be prompted to enter individual participant details.

If someone other than the original reservation holder will be entering participant information or submitting payment, please forward the confirmation email (which includes the reservation link) to that person.

Parent Portal Option

Troops also have the option to use the **Parent Portal**, which allows families to submit participant information for their Scout and, if desired, make payments directly. To help determine whether this option is a good fit for your troop, the following short videos may be helpful:
