On behalf of the St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee, Inc., I would like to thank you for participating in this year's St. Patrick's Day Parade.

Enclosed is your location map, unit coordinator ribbon, the 2023 Parade Route, and if applicable, vehicle hang tag(s). Please bring these items with you to the Parade for reference. Please wear your ribbon at all times to ensure that our Marshals know who is in charge of each unit.

Due to recent world events, the St. Patrick's Day Parade will have heightened security. All vehicles in Division 1, 2 and 3 **must** enter Superior Ave. from East 24th St. **Prior to entering the Staging Area, the Cleveland Police Department will conduct explosive sweeps of all vehicles and floats. Because of the extra time needed, please have vehicles arrive no later than 12 noon.**

Vehicles in the X Division, which marshal on East 18th St. enter from either Payne Ave. or Rockwell Ave. **The Cleveland Police Department will conduct explosive sweeps at these entry points. Vehicles will need to be in place no later than 12 noon. After 12 noon, access to East 18th St. will be closed by the Cleveland Police Department.**

If a vehicle does not have a hang-tag, the Cleveland Police Department and Parade Marshals will not permit it to enter the Staging Area or Parade Route. If you do not have the correct number of vehicle hang tags, please notify Deputy Director, Sarah O'Brien Dirk at 216-337-9004 or sdirk@stpatricksdayscleveland.com immediately.

Only vehicles participating in the Parade will be permitted in the Staging Area. Therefore, no passenger drop off will be allowed in the Staging Area. Passengers will need to be dropped off either on Rockwell Ave. or on Payne Ave. at one of the cross-streets, and walk to the Staging Area. No vehicles will be allowed to enter the cross-streets due to police barricades. **Once in the Staging Area, vehicles must NOT be left unattended.**

The Reviewing Stand will be located on the north side of East Roadway adjacent to Public Square. Cleveland's TV 20 will be filming the Parade from the intersection of Superior Ave. and West Roadway.

The Parade will begin promptly at 1:04pm on March 17th. Units in the Lead Division, Division I and Division II should be ready to march by 12:30pm. Division III units should be ready by 1:15pm.

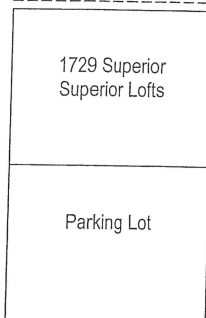
At the end of the Parade Route, we will be disbursing units with vehicles via Ontario Ave. or Rockwell Ave. Parade Marshals will direct your organization off the Parade Route.

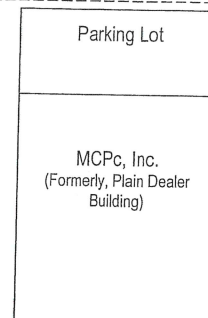

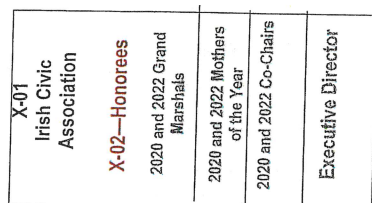

February 15, 2023

All vehicles in Divisions I, II and III must enter the staging area from E. 24th St and move westward into position. All vehicles participating in the parade must display the Parade-issued hang-tag at all times. Vehicles not displaying the hang-tag will not be permitted to enter the staging area. All vehicles will be swept by the Cleveland Police Department Bomb Squad.

Parade marshals, identified by the yellow arm bands, will assist you to your designated marshal location.

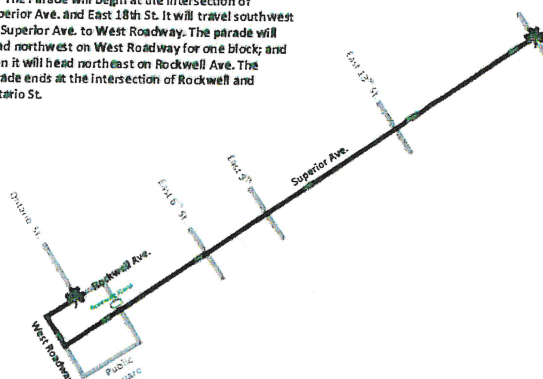
All buses and other vehicles not participating in the Parade will not be permitted to enter the staging area. Passengers must be dropped off either on Rockwell Ave or Payne Ave.

The Cleveland St. Patrick's Day Parade Line of March is subject to change.

The Parade will begin at the intersection of Superior Ave. and East 18th St. It will travel southwest on Superior Ave. to West Roadway. The parade will head northwest on West Roadway for one block; and then it will head northeast on Rockwell Ave. The parade ends at the intersection of Rockwell and Ontario St.
