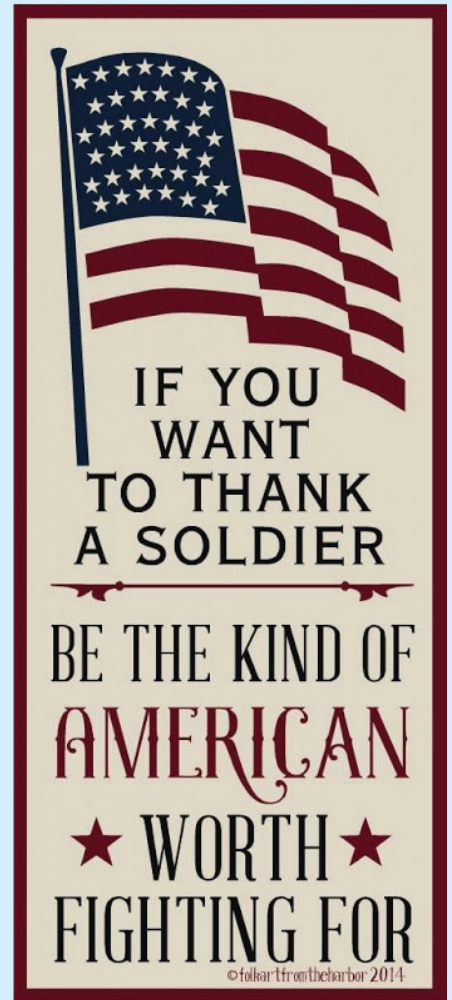
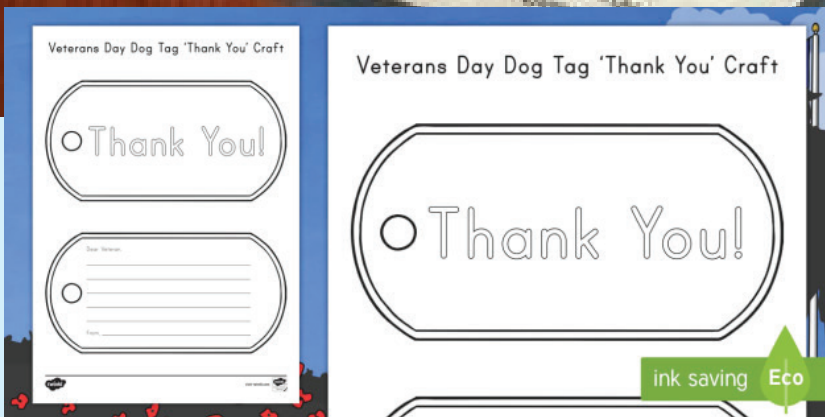

- 1 Download Paper Template
- 2 Optional: add tag variety by labeling Veteran, Army, Air Force, or Navy Etc.,
- 3 Copy, cut & hole punch
- 4 Cut strings & loop on tags
- 5 Add pens & pencils
- 6 Create a Table Sign
- 7 Add laminated instructions
- 8 Set-up & Secure Trees (trees available at Armory)

Heritage Display & Independent Flag Activity

- Design a Bulletin Board or Sturdy Display

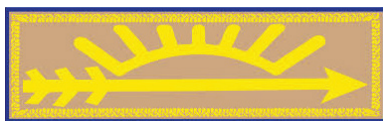

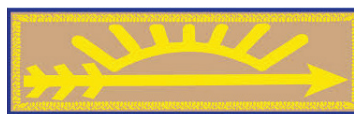
