At Beaumont Scout Reservation, no two weeks are the same. Each week, we schedule over 100 merit badges and activities tailored to meet your Scout's needs and interests. We are able to keep class sizes small, by asking Scouts what they would like to take during their week at camp. From here we build a custom schedule. Small classes allow Scouts to engage with the instructors and allows them to meet other Scouts from outside their units. Many of our Scouts work on an average of 4-6 merit badges or classes during their stay.

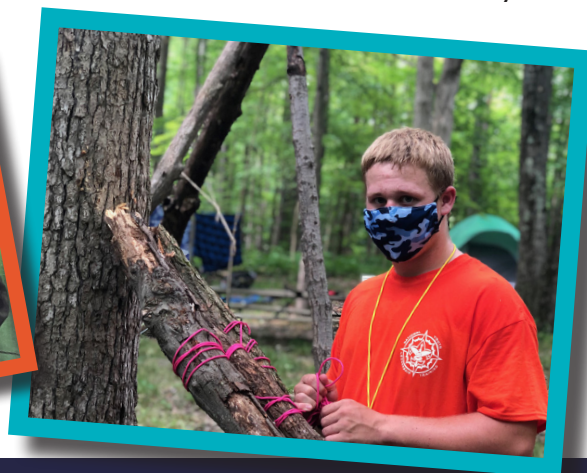
During your stay, we encourage you to participate in all that Beaumont has to offer. With over 100 merit badges and activities, there is sure to be something out there for everyone in 2022.
