MERIT BADGE PROGRAM

At Beaumont Scout Reservation, no two weeks are the same. Each week, we schedule over 100 merit badges and activities tailored to meet your Scout's needs and interests. We are able to keep class sizes small, by asking Scouts what they would like to take during their week at camp. From here we build a custom schedule. Small classes allow Scouts to engage with the instructors and allows them to meet other Scouts from outside their units. Many of our Scouts work on an average of 4-6 merit badges or classes during their stav.
