# Miami Valley Council 2024 Fall Campout Camper Guide

## Everything You Need to Know

#### **Participants:**

## **Check-in and Check-out Procedures:**

Friday check-in is from 5:30pm-8:00pm Saturday check-in is from 8:00am-8:30am Saturday only participants check out at 6:00pm-8:00pm Sunday check-out is from 8:00am-10:00am Check-in with the Camp Administration to turn in health forms and pick up camp schedule. Any campers needing to leave camp early must checkout with the Camp Administration and check-in upon return.

## **Check-in and Parking**

Check-in will be from 5pm to 8pm. Enter through the Carillon Blvd entrance (entrance closest to the river). Check-in at the registration tent. At registration the leader will need medical forms, part A and B for all campers and will be given a parking tag placed on dashboard. Campsites are assigned and you will be taken to your campsite. Unloading of trailers in marked spots in parking lot only, no trailers will be permitted in grassy area. After unloading trailers, they will then need to be moved to the maintenance parking lot. All vehicles staying on Carillon Property will need to have a parking tag placed on dashboard.

## **Space Restrictions**

Parking will be in the grass in a designated location.

## Communication

Adults and Staff will be sent updates, changes, weather updates and any emergencies via text messages. Be sure to register your contact number at registration.

## Cooking

You will need to plan meals for the weekend, with the exception of lunch, as LUNCH WILL BE PROVIDED!! Bring all needed supplies and remember **NO OPEN FLAMES. Bring water for your unit's needs.** Keep an eye on the weather and plan meals accordingly, hot drinks or cold drinks? Hot food or cold sandwiches?

## Pets

No pets are allowed to visit or stay during the Camporee. This includes dropping off equipment or cubs. This applies to all visitors and staff personnel. The only exception is licensed service animals.

## **Smoking and Alcohol Policy**

This is a smoke and alcohol-free event. The smoking of cigarettes, cigars, pipes and illegal substances are prohibited. The use of smokeless tobacco/electronic cigarettes are prohibited. All alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited. This policy applies to all leaders, parents/guardians. Violation of this policy will result in being asked to leave. Carillon Brewery OFF LIMITS to ALL Campers and Staff.

## **First Aid**

Each unit is responsible for providing basic first aid for their Cubs. If additional help is needed our First Aid staff will be located in the First Aid tent next to registration. Report any major illnesses or injury to the First Aid staff located at the First Aid tent.

## **Uniforms and Clothing**

Cubs and Scouters are to wear Class 'A' uniforms on Saturday. Lanyards received at check-in need to be worn at ALL TIMES. Not wearing your lanyard will deny you access to Carillon Park. No open toed shoes are to be worn at any time. Be prepared for Ohio fall weather!!

## **Cubs Leaving Early**

If at any time during the Camporee if any Cub or Adult need to leave early, the parent/guardian must sign out at the registration tent.

## **General Information**

- 1. Carillon Park Gift Shop will be open
- 2. You may want to bring a chair for the debriefing (closing ceremony) on Saturday night

## **General Rules**

- 1. Parents/guardians are responsible for all Cubs during the Camporee.
- 2. No Knives, sheath knives, candles, firecrackers, explosives, firearms are permitted.
- 3. No eating in tents, bugs and critters may visit you
- 4. Cubs cannot share medications.
- 5. No one is permitted to go barefoot
- 6. No campfires, charcoal or open flames
- 7. The buddy system and YPT guidelines are in effect at all times.

## Garbage

Each unit is responsible for disposing of their trash at check out in the dumpsters. Gray water to be disposed of in appropriate containers.

## Checkout

Checkout is between 8 and 10 am on Sunday. After loading and checking site for trash come to the registration tent for your check out inspection.

## Safety and Emergency

Weather notifications will be sent via the event communication to Unit leaders and Staff. Lanyards are to be worn at **ALL** times. If not worn, you will be denied access to activities. In case of heavy rain or electrical storm, take shelter in the park. During night hours if needed we will have access to a space in Carillon to take cover.
