

Fall on the Frontier Camper guide

Check-in and Check-out procedures:

Friday check-in is from 5:30pm-7:30pm

Saturday only check-in from 8:30am-9:00am

Sunday check out is from 8:00am-10:00am

Check-in with camp administration to turn in the Health form part a and b and to pick up camp Schedule. Any campers needing to leave camp Early must check out with the camp administration And check in upon return.



Everything You Need to Know:

1. Units will be camping together, bringing tents and personal items.
2. Meals, individuals/units will be responsible for all meals. Bring all needed supplies and remember **NO OPEN FLAMES. Bring water for your family/units needs.**
3. Program will be separated by rank, Lions, Tigers, Wolves and Bears will be together while Webelos and AOL's will be together. **Schedules will be posted soon for both groups.**
4. Uniform/what to wear- Class A during the day on Saturday is preferred however a Scouting Activity shirt works, colored wristband (provided at registration) and closed toe shoes (no sandals or croc's style shoes). Be prepared for the weather.
5. Camp runs on the **buddy system**, leaders must ensure that **every Cub camper** is paired with a buddy. Each Cub should know where their buddy is at all times and should not leave their buddy for any reason. This includes traveling to the restroom and program areas. Parents are **NOT** considered a buddy.
6. Pets are not permitted to visit or stay during the weekend. The only exception is a licensed service animal.

7. This is a smoke and alcohol-free event. The use of any tobacco products is prohibited and can only be used in the designated area. Please check the information table for location of permitted location.

8. All campers, adults, and visitors must check-in, receive and wear the camp wristband for while they are at camp. This ensures that, at a glance, everyone knows who belongs on camp and who does not. If a Cub needs to leave during the weekend be sure to check out at the information table.

9. A 'Lost and Found' box will be at the information table for items that are discovered at program stations or elsewhere during the weekend. Staff will make every effort to return items to the proper person. Labeling items with the camper's full name will assist in the rapid return of missing items.

10. Each unit is responsible for providing basic first aid. If additional help is needed our First Aid staff will be located in the First Aid tent next to the information table. ALL INJURIES MUST BE REPORTED REGARDLESS OF THE SEVERITY! NO EXCEPTIONS!!

Safety and Emergency

Weather notifications will be sent via the event communication to Unit leaders and Staff.

ALL Leaders, cubs and parents are expected to follow the directions of any event chair or staff member during the event of an emergency.

In the case of potential weather event chair or council staff will monitor the situation and make any decisions necessary to ensure the safety of those at camp.

Camp staff will do their best to keep units informed with up-to-date information.

Heavy rain or electrical storm: Camp activities will continue to take place even in light or moderate rain. In case of heavy rain or electrical storms units will move to a designated location to shelter.

Lost camper: While every precaution is made and many procedures are put in place, it remains a possibility that Scouts will get lost or separated from their group. The event has a plan to quickly locate the missing Scout and return them to their proper unit location.

Intruder: While this event is being held at a venue that will be open to the public we need to be diligent of those that are not wearing a wristband. If you see or suspect an intruder in camp, immediately and quietly notify a staff member. Event chair or council staff will question to ascertain who they are and why they are here, and they may be asked to leave. In the event an intruder intends to do harm to persons or properties, campers will be quickly and quietly moved to a safe location. Law enforcement will be notified by event chair or council staff, parents/guardians will be notified as soon as it is safe to do so.
