Registration Fees:

- Cub Scout Youth (Weekend or Day-Only) \$20 Regular Fee and \$30 Late Fee
- Siblings (Weekend or Day-Only) \$20 Regular Fee and \$30 Late Fee
- Adults (Weekend or Day-Only) \$10
- Race-Only (Youth or Adult) \$7
- Siblings 2 and under are free, but still need to be registered

Late fee begins April 12, 2026

Registration closes April 25, 2026 at 11:59 PM

Attention: Adults attending NOT in uniform will need to pay \$10 at the door for the race

Check in and check out procedures:

Check in at the check in tent close to the camping area. Anyone staying overnight must bring Part A and B of the BSA health form. These will be checked and verified by our medic at check in. Anyone beyond the check in tent must be checked in and wearing a wrist band.

Friday arrival: check in between 5:30pm and 8:00pm

Saturday only arrival: check in between 8:15am-8:45am

Race only arrival: check in between 4:15pm and 6:00pm

Sunday check out: check out between 9:00am- 10:30am

Leaving early: check out at the registration tent

Everything you need to know

1. Camping will be in units. Units provide tents, meals (dinner Saturday can be concession stand while you watch the race) and personal items.

2. Camping areas will be assigned upon arrival.

3. There will be no access to electric or water. Be sure to bring water for your family/units needs.
4. No Ground fires, above ground fire pits and camp stoves are permitted
5. Uniform/what to wear- a Scouting activity shirt is ok for anytime except while at the race track. Class A uniforms need to be worn to the race track. Adults without a Class A shirt you will need to pay \$10 at the gate to enter the race. Be sure to wear your wristband throughout the weekend. Closed toe shoes (no sandals or croc style shoes). Be prepared for the weather.
6. Pets are not permitted to visit or stay during the weekend. The only exception is a licensed service animal.
7. **This is a smoke and alcohol free event.** The use of any tobacco products is prohibited and can only be used in the designated area. Please check the information table for the location of permitted location.
8. All campers, adults, and visitors must check-in, receive and wear the camp wristband for while at camp. This ensures that, at a glance, everyone knows who belongs on camp and who does not. If someone needs to leave during the weekend be sure to check out at the registration tent.
9. Each unit is responsible for providing basic first aid. If additional help is needed our Medic staff will be located in the First Aid Tent next to the registration table. **ALL INJURIES MUST BE REPORTED!**
10. Ear protection is highly recommended for both youth and adults. You may also want eye protection as this is a dirt track.

Safety and Emergency

Weather notifications will be sent via the event communication to Unit leaders and Staff.

In case of a potential weather event, the chair or Council staff will monitor the situation and make any decisions necessary to ensure the safety of those at camp.

Heavy rain or electrical storm: Camp activities will continue to take place even in light or moderate rain. In case of heavy rain or electrical storms units will move to a designated location to shelter.

Lost camper: While every precaution is made and many procedures are put in place, it remains a possibility that Scouts will get lost or separated from their group. The event has a plan to quickly locate the missing Scout and return them to their proper unit location.

Intruder: While this event is being held at a venue that will be open to the public we need to be diligent of those that are not wearing a wristband. If you see or suspect an intruder in camp, immediately and quietly notify a staff member. The event chair or Council staff will question to ascertain who they are and why they are here, and they may be asked to leave. In the event an intruder intends to do harm to persons or properties, campers will be quickly quietly moved to a safe location. Law enforcement will be notified by event chair or council staff, parents/guardians will be notified as soon as it is safe to do so.
