Tips and Timeline for Participation in Scouting for Food 100!

8	Contact your local food bank or pantry to make sure they need help
H	Determine how many Scouts will participate and how many adults will be available to drive when picking up food

	Determine how your unit will be participating (there are multiple ways possible)
RCH	Determine the number of door hangers and collection boxes needed to pick up at April Roundtable
MA	Fill out the commitment form online - before April Roundtable
	Talk to other units to get them to participate (consider a friendly competition)

	L	Pick up your supplies at April Roundtable or at the council service center
ADRI	APRIL	Collect as many non-perishable goods as possible
	1	Your unit can participate throughout the month, but the offical drive week is Saturday, April 21- Saturday, April 28.

Ways You Can Collect Food:

There are many ways to collect food. The Miami Valley Council will provide all the door hangers and boxes you need to make your food drive a success. Just commit to participate online!

- $\sqrt{}$ Go door-to-door by dropping off a door hanger one weekend and returning the next weekend to collect the food items on the doorstep.
- $\sqrt{}$ Send home a letter at your Church. Make an announcement one weekend and then collect the bags filled with canned goods the next weekend.
- $\sqrt{}$ Set up a collection box at your school, service club, church, or chartered organization. Keep it up the entire month of April.
- $\sqrt{}$ Set up collection boxes at area businesses. Keep them up the entire month of April.
