## **SCOUT FISHING DERBY**

HEN: Sunday, August 12, 2023

- WHERE: Tampier Lake West End 131<sup>st</sup> and Will Cook Road (Take Southwest Highway to 131<sup>st</sup> Street. Go west on 131<sup>st</sup> to Will Cook Road. Turn left on Will Cook Road. Proceed to parking entrance on the left.)
- TIME: Fishing begins at 9:30am and ends at 12:30pm. All "caught" fish must be brought to the shelter to be measured no later than 12:45pm. Please note, no fish will be measured after 1:00pm. Prize trophies will be awarded at approximately 1:15pm.
- **WHO:** Fishing Derby is open to registered Lions, Tigers, Bears, Webelos, Scouts BSA and their siblings. *Please make sure your Scouts and families know their pack / troop number*.
- **COST:** \$10.00 per Scout or sibling (includes a fishing derby patch). \$5.00 Adults. Extra patches may be ordered for an additional \$4.00 each.

# RULES

1. Fishing is to begin at 9:30am.

#### 2. NO SCOUTS OR SIBLINGS ARE ALLOWED TO FISH IN BOATS.

3. This is a "catch and release" fishing derby. Place "caught" fish in a bucket containing water and bring to shelter to be measured as soon as possible. Fishing Derby Staff will release the measured fish back into the lake.

# 4. All "caught" fish must be brought to the shelter for measurement no later than 12:45pm.

- 5. Bait may be purchased at the Bait House Shop, located at the first entrance west of Wolf Road on 131<sup>st</sup> St. (east end of Tampier Lake). Or, you may bring your own bait.
- 6. When a scout or sibling brings a fish to the measuring tables at the shelter for the first time, a staff member will confirm that the youth's name is listed on the registration sheet.
- 7. This is a family outing. Please encourage the entire family to join us.
