Ideally the Class A will be worn outside of layers underneath. If temperature or weather is a factor the appropriate outer layer should be worn or available. The route is 103^{rd} to 115^{th} and will dispense between 116th to 119^{th} .

All units are responsible for their participant's transportation to and from the event as well any handing off to parents or guardian.
