



Wood Badge is advanced leadership training for Cub Scout, Scouts BSA and Venturing adult leaders at the unit, district, council, and professional levels. It is taught by living the experience of a Scouts BSA Troop, utilizing the patrol method, over two weekends.

Wood Badge teaches leadership skills by focusing on five key areas: Living the Values, Growing, Connecting, Guiding and Empowering. By using a variety of learning techniques, including lectures, demonstrations, group discussions, and hands on exercises, participants will learn contemporary leadership skills and tools needed to provide the youth members of their units with the highest scouting experience.

- Open to registered members of the BSA, have current Youth Protection Training, provide current BSA Medical Form Part A, B, C and be "Trained" for their registered position.
- · During both weekends, participants will tent camp.
- First weekend meals will be prepared by the staff. Second weekend meals will be prepared using the patrol method, in patrol campsites.
