SCOUTS BSA ROBOTICS MERIT BADGE CLINIC

Building and using the Hydraulic Robotic Arm Kit, Scouts will learn about the basics of robotics and fluid power while earning the Robotics Merit badge!

In partnership with the National Fluid Power Association and Triton College, this is a single-day clinic where only Robotics Merit Badge requirements 4 & 5 will be completed. All other Robotics Merit Badge workbook requirements should be completed prior to attendance. The Merit Badge Counselors on hand will sign Scout's blue cards if the workbook is complete. We will ONLY have time during the clinic for Scouts to complete requirements 4 & 5. During the clinic, Scouts will need to complete a robot engineering notebook. Scouts will NOT be provided a notebook during the clinic and should attend with a notebook or binder with loose-leaf paper.

Scouts will work individually to build the pictured above Hydraulic Robotic Arm Kit. Each Scout will take their kit home.

The maximum allowed attendance is 32 Scouts, so please register now before clinic fills up!
