
*Cell Phone Policy: PTAC National Youth Leadership Training
Effective October 2025*

If you bring a cell phone to a Pathway to Adventure Council National Youth Leadership Training course, you agree to the following expectations:

1. Cell phones **may not** be used during scheduled course activities and meals.
2. Cell phones **may not** be loaned to others.
3. Cell phones **may** be used for an alarm clock or appropriate personal use outside of scheduled course activities and meals, so long as they do not disrupt others.

Failure to adhere to these expectations will result in the following escalation of consequences:

1. Written warning
2. Confiscation for the remainder of the day
3. Confiscation for the remainder of the course

If you do not bring a cell phone to course, an adult staff member will assist you with communicating to your parents/guardians as needed. Adult staff contact information will be shared with parents/guardians prior to course.

Note that cell service and charging facilities are limited at camp. Your cell phone is your responsibility.
