BASIC ADULT LEADER OUTDOOR ORIENTATION

BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation) is the required training for Cub Scout leaders planning outdoor activities, including pack campouts and Webelos den overnights.

BALOO training is comprised of two parts - an online component and this practical, hands-on component. Both must be completed to qualify as BALOO trained. The online component is available through the Scouting America LearnCenter at my.scouting.org and must be completed prior to the practical component.

This overnight training experience covers essential outdoor skills, including GPS and navigation, aquatics, gear selection, hiking and nature, outdoor ethics, cooking and sanitation, first aid, Cub Scout knife safety, and more.

Online registration is required. Participants will receive an equipment list before the course. Scouting America Medical Forms A & B are required.

- BSA Medical form A and B
- Tent (we are sleeping outside, not in the cabins)
- Good Weather
- Sleeping bag/pillow if you use one
- Cot, if you use one
- Camp chair
- Class A uniform for arrival and flags
- Comfortable clothes and hiking/walking shoes
- Rain gear
- Mess kit w/mug for hot drinks
- Water bottle
- Toiletries
- Pen/notebook
- Flashlight
