Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) provides Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, and other adult leaders with the outdoor skills Scouts learn through the First Class rank.

Through hands-on instruction, participants will learn essential Scouting skills such as cooking, fire building, orienteering, knot tying, camping skills, and more. All adult leaders are welcome, including committee members, Webelos leaders, and Crew Advisors.

IOLS is a required training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters. Additional required online trainings include Scoutmaster & Assistant Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training and Hazardous Weather Training, both available through **My.Scouting.org**.
