WEEKEND CAMPERS

Check-in will be from 6:00pm to 8:00pm, at the Welcome Center, on Friday. Campsites will be assigned prior to arrival. There will be a brief Leader's Meeting in the Dining Hall at 9:00pm, with a Cracker Barrel (Snack) immediately after. Opening Flags will be at 9:00am on Saturday, in the Lower Parade Field (by the parking lot). The Open Programming will go from 9:00am - 4:00pm, with lunch from 12:00pm - 1:00pm in the Dining Hall. Saturday evening will feature a unique Crossover & Awards Ceremony, at the Council Ring, followed by a Movie Night in the Dining Hall with snacks. There will be an interfaith service on Sunday morning, at 9:00am, at the Chapel. All campsites need to be cleaned and everyone out of camp by 11:00am on Sunday.

SATURDAY ONLY PARTICIPANTS

Check-in will be from 8:00am - 8:45am, at the Welcome Center. Opening Flags will be at 9:00am, in the Lower Parade Field (by the parking lot). The Open Programming runs from 9:00am - 4:00pm, with lunch from 12:00pm - 1:00pm in the Dining Hall. Packs are more than welcome to stick around for the Crossover & Awards Ceremony and Movie Night, but they will be responsible for their own dinner.

CUBMASTERS

Thank you for volunteering your time and giving your unit this opportunity. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out.

CAMPSITES

We will be camping in North Camp. Campsites will be assigned prior to arrival at MVSR. If you utilize the picnic tables, please return them up against the trees. If you use the fire rings, please return them to behind the KYBO and properly dispose of all ash and wood. This makes it easier for the Camp Ranger to mow the campsites.

VEHICLES/TRAILERS

Packs will be allowed to drive back to the campsites, 1 (one) vehicle per unit at a time. Trailers may be left at the campsites, parked on the side of the road, not in the campsites. All vehicles must be returned to the parking lot.

FIRES

Campfires are permitted in fire rings only. Fire rings are located by the KYBOs. Please return fire rings to behind the KYBO on Sunday and properly dispose of all ash and wood. Before grabbing wood from the woodsheds, please collect sticks and branches from within your campsites and the wood line. This helps keep our camp and campsites clean. If you do collect wood from the woodsheds, please return all unused wood back to the woodsheds. Please remember to never leave a fire unattended!

TRASH

Please pick up after yourselves and help us practice **Leave No Trace** principles. Trash bags can be thrown away at the dumpsters behind the Dining Hall. Please do not leave any trash in the campsites or KYBOs.

OPEN PROGRAM INFORMATION

There is no set schedule for the day. An open program means that you can enjoy whichever parts of the program you want to. You can spend all day either fishing, shooting or giving service back to the camp... or you can do a little bit of everything. The choice is yours! *Parents and leaders, please make sure that all Cub Scouts and youth are supervised at all times.*

WEATHER IN THE SPRING (IN OHIO)

Please dress appropriately for the weather. It is Spring in Ohio... It could be sunny and 75, or 3 feet of snow and 28. "Be Prepared!"

SHOOTING

There will be shooting events all over camp: Cowboy Action Slingshots, BB Guns, Archery, Slingshots, Giant Slingshots, Tomahawk Throwing, and Jarts!

Cub Scouts are prohibited from using weapons, of any kind, not provided by the camp. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING PERSONAL FIREARMS!**

FISHING

- There will be several awards available including longest fish, heaviest fish, and most fish caught!
- Please bring your own fishing gear **AND** your own bait!
- Limited fishing gear will be available to borrow for those Scouts who do not have their own.
