What is Fall Encampment?

Fall Encampment is an encampment for Scouts BSA Boy and Girl Troops and Venturers to learn in-depth skills and unique opportunities. This year we are offering experiences in Shooting Sports, Astronomy, Fire Safety, E-Prep, First Aid, Fishing, Leatherwork, Oceanography, Surveying, and Dutch Oven Cooking.

Youth participants will choose their weekend program. The youth working on Astronomy, Fishing, Metalworking, Surveying, E-Prep will cover requirements for the merit badges, but may not be completed in the available.

All meals are to be provided by the units.

Who may participate?

Any registered Scouts BSA Boy or Girl and/or registered Venturer may participate in the shooting sports or Merit Badge Classes. Some special sessions may require youth to be at least 14 years of age and First Class, or registered Venturers.
