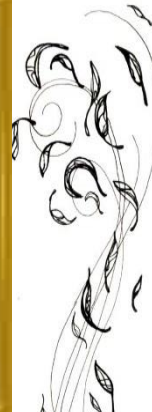
Specific Schedules will be provided upon check in. All events are scheduled to give participants the best experience possible.
