

The NRA Basics of Shotgun Shooting course introduces students to the **knowledge, skills** and **attitude** necessary for owning and using a Shotgun safely. Through this course, the student will learn about Shotgun parts and operation, ammunition, gun safety, Shotgun shooting fundamentals, and Shotgun shooting activities. The Basics of Shotgun Shooting course is a prerequisite for participation in the NRA Shotgun Instructor course.

The curriculum includes both classroom and range activities. You must bring your own Eye and Hearing Protection, and wear comfortable clothing for outdoor activity. *You may bring your own 12ga or 20ga Shotgun. Some Shotguns will be available for loan.*

Your package includes the NRA Shotgun Shooting Handbook, Ammunition and Targets, plus expendable materials.

You must be at least 21 yrs. of age, and a registered member of the BSA to attend this course.
