Shotgun Instructor Course

Successful completion of the Shotgun Instructor Course will fulfill the practical requirements for the Scouter to apply for full instructor certification through the National Rifle Association. BSA policy requires Shotgun instruction must be done by a currently-certified NRA Shotgun Instructor.

To attend this course: You must be at least 21 yrs. old.

You must have completed the NRA Basic Shotgun Shooting Course You must have completed NRA Basic Instructor Training (BIT)

Participants will be working in the classroom as well as on the range. This course is intended to give the instructor candidate practical experience in safe Shotgun handling, instructing the basic skills of Shotgun shooting, conducting the NRA Basic Shotgun Shooting Course, and counseling the Shotgun Shooting awards programs.

The curriculum includes both classroom and range activities. You must bring your own Eye and Hearing Protection, and wear comfortable clothing for outdoor activity. You may bring your own 12ga or 20ga Shotgun. Some Shotguns will be available for loan. Ammunition, targets and other expendables will be provided.

Brown Bag lunch as there will not be adequate time to go off-site.

You must be at least 21 yrs. of age, and a registered member of the BSA to attend this course.
