Cub Scout Rangemaster Training

Cub Scout shooting sports programs may be conducted only on a district or council level. Archery, BB gun, and slingshot shooting are restricted to day camps, Cub Scout/Webelos Scout resident camps, council-managed camping programs (Cub World), or council activities where there are currently trained Cub Scout Rangemasters and all standards for BSA shooting sports are enforced.

You must be a registered scouter to attend this course.

Cub Scout Rangemaster training is valid for 2 years.

Class size is limited to the first 32 reservations (application with the \$10.00 fee) Registration is required no later than April 1.
