CAN I ATTEND INDIVUDALLY AS A FAMILY? You sure can! We would love to have you and your Scout! BSA guidelines require one parent/ guardian for every Scout attending camp if attending as not part of a Pack/ Den

WHAT WILL SOME ACTIVITIES BE? Activities are based on the Cub Scout Advance Program with age-appropriate activities designed to be FUN and have the Scouts earning advancemen along the way. The camp is rounded out by camp-wide activities each evening, including a movie night and the beloved campfire. The skits and songs performed by each group are famous for their silliness and fun and will be remembered by your Scout for many years. Dig into some yummy food prepared by our volunteer staff. Don't let this opportunity blow by! Dive in and get ready for a weekend of fun and adventure! We will also be doing:

- Shooting Sports (BB's &Archery)
- Water Slide
- Climbing on the indoor wall
- S.T.E.M. Games & Activities

FOOD & DIETARY NEEDS: Providing healthy and nutritious meals helps to keep Scouts (...and adults) powered during their time at camp. Our menus are dietitian-approved and we do our best to accommodate special dietary needs. All meals are served in our AIR -CONDITIONED dining hall.

HIGH-QUALITY FACILITIES: Your outdoor experience is important to us and we want you to have the best camping experience possible. Campsites have access to flush restrooms. Our dining hall is large and air-conditioned. Pavilions and indoor buildings for classrooms are available.

PACK COORDINATOR: Each Pack (or Den) needs to select at least one person to serve as their Pack Camp Coordinator. This person will help promote and get everyone signed up for camp. They will also help coordinate logistics on travel and gather all paperwork to check in the group at the same time during check-in.

HEALTH & MEDICAL: Each Scout and adult attending must bring a completed BSA medical form to camp (Pack Coordinators should collect all forms and bring them to check in at camp). The camp will have a medical officer site during camp for any medical needs.

WHAT TO BRING? Be sure to check out the full Camp Parent/ Leader Guide for a complete checklist of items to bring to camp. In general you will need to bring:

- Camping gear including:
 - Tent
 - Sleeping bag/ padding
 - Flashlights
 - Night time clothing
- Outdoor clothing (short, shirt, shoes, hat, etc.), rain gear, *light* jacket.
 - All campers receive a camp t-shirt as a part of their fee.
- Swimsuit or cloths that can get wet
- Toiletries
- Cub Scout Uniform
- Medications (adults will keep and dispense after discussing with onsite medical personal.
- Bug spray, sunscreen, etc.

HOW DO WE SIGN UP? First talk to your Pack Leadership and find out who your Pack Camp Coordinator is and work with them directly to see what session of camp the Pack is attending. Then fill out the attached sign up to give to your Pack Coordinator with your fees or go to:
