All Scouts will learn about the amateur radio hobby – what it is, types of equipment, and how to use it. Scouts will have an opportunity to practice 2-way radio communications using various types of equipment and protocols. Scouts will listen to and talk to other scouts with ham radio operators participating across the world during Jamboree-on-the-Air. Scouts can also learn to transmit by key their first name in morse code to another CW station.

It's a global STEM event since Amateur radio is all about science and technology. Hams use less power than a common light bulb to interact with others around the world. Scouts will learn about the underlying principles of science.

Get your FCC Ham license!

There will be an Optional FCC 35-question Technician License Written exam given that covers basic regulations, operating practices and electronics theory. Everyone who passes will go home with your very own handheld ham radio.

Test session is 3:45-4:45pm. Cost is \$5 per youth/\$15 Adult
