

## Leave No Trace Trainer

This course is 16 hours of classroom and experiential learning done over a period of 1 evening and 1 weekend. We will be camping and you will be responsible for your meals for the weekend.

We will be covering history of Leave No Trace, Wildland Ethics, Front Country issues and the 7 Principles of Leave No Trace. We will also cover Outdoor Ethics BSA Advancements and Awards, BSA Leave No Trace resources for teaching and Why Leave No Trace in Scouting.

Participants will be required to give a presentation to the class on a Leave No Trace Principle assigned by the Lead Instructor (required to pass and receive LNT Trainer Certificate).

You must be a registered scout (14 years old and older) or scouter to attend this course.
