



## PINE TREE PERSONAL EQUIPMENT LIST

#### **UNIFORM**

1 #Official Boy Scout Shorts

(May use single pair of Switchback Pants/Shorts instead of separate pairs of long pants and shorts)

1 #Official Boy Scout Trousers – Fall only

1 Official Boy Scout short sleeve shirt

- 1 Official Boy Scout metal neckerchief slide
- 1 Official Boy Scout Cap (Olive Green)
- 1 Official Boy Scout web belt
- 1 Set of official Boy Scout <u>olive green</u> shoulder loops
- 2 Pair of official Scout socks (solid green new Scout crew socks NO ankle socks)
- 1 \*Pair hiking boots or sturdy comfortable shoes (NO canvas tennis shoes, sandals, or open toed shoes)
- 1 \*Jacket (Be prepared for the weather and seasonal changes that can occur)
- 1 \*Rain poncho or other rain gear
  - \*Underwear for three days
- 2 Boy Scout tee shirts any Boy Scout or Troop tee shirts are acceptable (No non-Scout tee shirts except plain solid color)

# Official Switchback pants fill the requirement for both of these.

### \*\*CANDIDATES MUST SHOW UP TO THE COURSE IN FULL FIELD UNIFORM (CLASS "A")

#### PATCHES ON UNIFORM SHIRT

Right sleeve – American Flag

Left sleeve – Official Indian Nations Council shoulder strip (See example at top--NO Jamboree or Trailblazer strips)

Left sleeve - Pine Tree Troop number 127 (as provided)

Above left pocket – World Brotherhood Crest (2" above left pocket centered)

# NO OTHER PATCHES OR BADGES SHOULD BE WORN ON YOUR SHIRT WHEN YOU REPORT

### **PERSONAL GEAR**

Plate, Bowl, Cup (with belt loop or lanyard), knife, fork, spoon, canteen or water bottle

\*Toilet articles (towel, washcloth, soap, mirror, comb, toothbrush and toothpaste)

Waterproof ground cloth

Sleeping bag, pillow

\*Cot

Scout Handbook

Compass

Two ball point pens

Small pocketknife for cutting binders twine (NO large locking blade or sheath knives)

Matches in waterproof container

Small flashlight with extra bulb and batteries

Personal first aid kit

Cheap wrist watch

\*50 feet of 1/4 inch sisal rope (no cotton or nylon)

\*Cold weather items (as necessary for the season)

Backpack with rain cover

Insect repellant (lotion OR stick – NO AEROSOL CANS OF ANY TYPE)

NO OTHER ITEMS WILL BE NEEDED FOR THE COURSE – DO NOT BRING ANYTHING NOT LISTED ABOVE. CELL PHONES, COMPUTER GAMES, I-PODS, and OTHER ELECTRONICS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED - NO EXCEPTIONS!! (Adult Staff Members will have cell phones for emergency use, if necessary.)

Please check with your Troop for items you can borrow if you do not have them.
