

BSA Climbing Instructor Training Level 2

April 12 -14 & 26-28 2024

Camp Meriwether & Horsethief Butte



Become a BSA Climbing Instructor

Participants will enjoy two weekends of classroom and hands-on training, including instruction in climbing technique, safety considerations, gear selection and care, group instruction and route selection and set-up. These topics will be presented by experienced members of the council climbing committee.

The first weekend will focus on classroom learning and introduction to practice at Camp Meriwether. The second weekend will be hands-on skills at Horsethief Butte. Home base will be Camp Baldwin for second session. Both sessions are required

Youth aged 16 and 17 are able to attend with a paying adult, but only those 18 and older are eligible to receive *BSA Climbing Instructor card*. Individuals satisfactorily demonstrating their instructional, management and technical skills will receive a training card as a *BSA Climbing Instructor Level I or Level II*, depending on demonstrated capability.

Course prerequisites: MUST have prior climbing experience; this is not a beginner class. Must also be current in Youth Protection training, Weather Hazard training, Climb-On Safely training and have a current BSA Medical Form, Part A, B & C signed by a physician.
