

2025 Wauna La-Mon'tay Lodge Event Attendee Code of Conduct

The general welfare of our group depends on the conduct of each individual; this ensures the success of lodge events and provides the maximum benefit to everyone. As an Arrowman, I understand this and support the reasonable demands of conduct expected of me.

I understand the lodge leadership is responsible for supervision with respect to maintaining discipline, security and safety of all participants; and for enforcing the Wauna La-Mon'tay Code of Conduct. As a member of Wauna La-Mon'tay Lodge I will help enforce these policies to the best of my ability.

As a member of the Order of the Arrow and a participant at a Wauna La-Mon'tay lodge event, I will:

1. Observe the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and the Order of the Arrow Obligation.
2. Follow all BSA Youth Protection rules and guidelines.
3. Use social media apps appropriately and in accordance with the Scout Oath and Law.
4. Observe quiet hours and lights out as per the event schedule.
5. Not change my officially assigned sleeping quarters without permission from the event leadership.
The reason(s), amongst others:
 - a) Youth Protection, and
 - b) Emergency calls, for example, could not be delivered when room changes are unofficial.
6. Allow no person to be in or occupy my bunkroom or sleeping quarters, other than those assigned by the event leadership. (Follow all BSA, OA, and Youth Protection rules and guidelines.)
7. Wear suitable, activity appropriate, clothing and footwear at all times during the event.
8. Observe all rules regarding the use of the waterfront, beach, shooting sports, climbing, and other camp or event facilities.
9. I will at all times use and observe the "buddy system". If I am going to a place other than the event HQ or general activity area, or my assigned bunk area – such as going for a walk around the camp/facilities, or to the beach (such as at Camp Meriwether) – I will notify event leadership and sign out in the log stating where my buddy and I are going, when we expect to return, and with whom (all persons sign out/sign back in).
10. Keep my sleeping quarters clean and orderly and dispose of trash in proper receptacles.
11. Attend all planned training and general sessions.
12. Attend Evening Flag, Dinner, and Evening Program in Full Uniform. At all other times participants may wear an OA or BSA shirt. Official Scout shorts, skirt, or trousers are encouraged.
13. Be personally and financially responsible for breakage, damage, or loss of property.
14. Refrain from the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs at the lodge event, as they are not permitted and will result, at a minimum, in immediate dismissal from the Wauna La-Mon'tay lodge event. This standard applies to all youth and adult participants.
15. Comply with federal, state and city laws, and BSA rules and regulations, including those that prohibit the use of fireworks, firearms, and gambling. Infraction of these laws and regulations will, at a minimum, be cause for immediate dismissal from the Wauna La-Mon'tay lodge event. I am aware and further understand that certain situations may require Lodge and/or Council leadership to inform law enforcement of possible/alleged illegal activities.
16. Abide by the BSA, OA, and Wauna La-Mon'tay Lodge NO SMOKING or VAPING policies at all times.
17. At all times, be a considerate guest of the host facility and facility staff.
