BRING YOUR OWN CAR!!!!!!!!!!!!

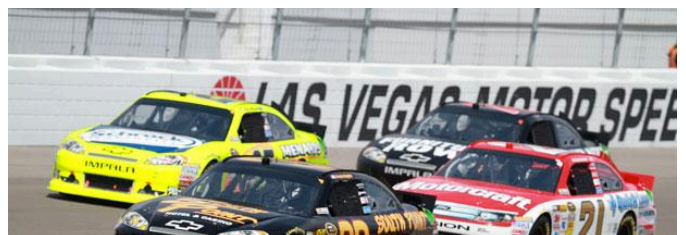
There are two events that will require the patrol to have a “driveable” car. You can make it as large or small as you like as long as your patrol fits in it or at least one of your patrol members. The others can drive it from outside. The two events will be judged. 1st. Show up to flags in your car. 2nd The patrol must be able to move it with at least one patrol member inside to each event (pitstops.)

Patrol Events (Pit Stops):

1. Car Crash Victims. What happened, how can you help them? (First Aid)
2. Knot with this car! (Knots) Run by Troop 121
3. Use the fire to drop the car. (Firebuilding) Run by Crew 42 and Troop 108
4. Which cars can you remember? (Kim’s Game) Run by Troop 20
5. Watch out for that tire, don’t slip in the oil, make it to the finish line. (Minefield) Run by Troop 215
6. Car tent camping. Put up and take down the tent the fastest. (Tent)
7. Build an “engine stand” to hold a 5 pound weight off the ground. (Lashings)
8. Put on a skit to teach (Leave No Trace Principles) Run by Terri Jackson Troop 150
9. Look! I think I found it. (Compass Course) Run by 150
10. Drive a car over the bridge, land in the “water.” How fast can you rescue your buddy? (Water Rescue)
