

Suggested Unit Gear Packing List

This is a suggested list of items a unit may bring to make the campsite feel more like home while at camp. Most infrastructure (Adirondacks, food) is provided by the camp.

Camp Spirit

- Troop/Pack Yell**
- Unit Flag & Stand:** To mark your site entrance and for morning colors.
- Gateway Materials:** Spars and rope for building a camp entrance (Scouts BSA).

General Campsite Items

- The "Binder":** Medical forms (Parts A, B, and C) and unit roster.
- Large First Aid Kit:** For the campsite.
- Lanterns:** Battery or gas powered or the common areas at night.
- Disinfectant Wipes/Spray:** For times when not near washstands.
- Clothesline & Pins:** Essential for drying wet towels and swimsuits daily.
- Tool Kit:** Hammer, multi-tool, or duct tape for quick gear repairs.
- Paracord/Bank Line:** For lashing projects or emergency clotheslines.
- Trunk/Footlocker:** For storing communal items securely from critters.

Downtime & Fun

- Deck of Cards / Board Games**
- Frisbee / Football / Soccer Ball**
- Skit/Song Props & Costumes:** For campfires.

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Extras (Optional Special Items)

- Door Mats:** Small rugs to put in front of adirondacks to keep the dirt out.
- Camp Stove:** For making coffee, tea, or hot chocolate right in the campsite.
- Pots & Pans:** If your unit prefers to do supplemental cooking or needs hot water for cocoa.
- Notebooks, pens & pencils:** Extra supplies for Merit Badge work or campsite logs (someone always forgets theirs!).
- Hammocks:** For nap time or sleeping (check the Hammock Guidelines).
- Personal Tents:** Bringing extra tents particularly for adults to have more flexibility to spread out.

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
