

IOLS – Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills



For Scouts BSA leaders, Venturing leaders, and Cub Scout leaders with more outdoor experience. These outdoor skills will help you guide the youth as they move through Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class ranks. The course also gives you experience working as part of a Patrol.

Participants will be need to bring camping equipment (tent, sleeping bag, sleeping pad), Uniform shirt, clothes suitable for the weather, pocket knife, notebook, pen or pencil, compass, and a flashlight. You also need to bring a copy of your Health form. The form will be turned in at check-in on Saturday morning and returned when you leave on Sunday morning.

Please dress for the weather. We will be outdoors most of the weekend. We will be at 7 Mountains Scout Camp at the Kurtz Cabin/Wald Campsite. Check-in will be Saturday morning at 8:00 AM on 4/27/2024 and check-out will be approximately 10:30 AM, Sunday, 4/28/2024.
