2024 Summer Camp Dates: Saturday, June 29th to Wednesday, July 3rd

Day Programming: 9:15 - 3:30pm

- Scouts will be organized into groups based on their Den sizes to rotate through various program areas with each session being one hour long
- All groups will visit each Program Area twice over the duration of camp
- Program Areas to include Aquatics at the Pool, Archery, BB Shooting Sports, Handicraft, Nature, Scoutcraft, Scouting Games, STEM Activities
- If the pool or shooting ranges are limited during T-storms, impacted groups will have first priority during afternoon Open Programming or will try to make up during Scout Siesta

Afternoon Open Programming: 3:30-5:30pm

- Aquatics, Scoutcraft & Shooting Sports program areas will be open. If any Scouts missed out on swimming or shooting due to weather, they will have first priority
- Will have organized camp-wide games such as Kickball, Capture the Flag, Cornhole, Wiffle Ball Home Run Derby, Spikeball, Soccer, Volleyball, etc.

Evening Programming: After dinner starting at 7:00pm

- Evening #1: reserved for a Safe Swim Defense presentation and Opening Ceremony
- Evening #2: reserved for camp-wide games (indoor and outdoor options provided)
- Evening #3: reserved for Scout Trivia and Minute-It-to-Win-It style games. For anybody interested, a Night Hike and Stargazing will also be available
- Evening #4: reserved for a Scout Skills Relay Race Challenge & a S'Mores Celebration

Closing Campfire Ceremony on the Last Day

- WIII consist of Scout-led songs, skits & cheers. Family members are welcome to attend
- Recognitions will be given out for Program Areas & Scout Skills Relay Race Challenge
- Goal is to end by 5:30pm. Scouts will depart at the conclusion of the ceremony

Meal Planning

- Allergy safe and dietary restricted meal options will be made available
- All Breakfasts and Dinners will be in the Dining Hall
- Lunches will be Grab 'n Go style to allow Scouts to eat outdoors or under pavilions
- During the Scout Siesta period, Unit Leaders will have a meeting while camp staff will help manage game stations for Scouts (i.e. volleyball, human foosball, cornhole, etc)
