



Cub Scout Day & Family Camp: 2024 Overview

2024 Summer Camp Dates: Sunday, July 21st to Wednesday, July 24th

Day Camp Programming: 9:15 - 3:30pm

- Scouts will be organized into groups based on Den sizes and grade levels to rotate through various program areas with each session being one hour long
- All groups will visit each Outdoor Adventure themed program area twice over the duration of camp (as long as they attend all available days)
- Program Areas to include Aquatics at the Pool, Archery, BB Shooting Sports, Handicraft, Nature, Scoutcraft, Scouting Games, and STEM Activities
- If the pool or shooting ranges are limited during T-storms, impacted scouts will have first priority during Resident Camp Open Programming or will try to make up during Siesta

Scout Spirit Closing: 3:30-4:00pm

- Will provide a transitional period to allow for any Day Campers to depart camp and for Family overnight campers to return to their respective campsites
- On the last day, this period will be used to provide recognition for accomplishments

Family Camp Afternoon Programming: 4:00-5:30pm

- The first day is reserved for Scouts, Leaders and Parents to get settled into campsites
- On Days 2 & 3, this timeframe will be reserved for:
 - Open programming at Aquatics, Scoutcraft & Shooting sports program areas.
 - Will have organized camp-wide games such as Kickball, Capture the Flag, Cornhole, Wiffle Ball Home Run Derby, Spikeball, Soccer, etc

Family Camp Evening Programming: After dinner starting at 7:00pm

- Evening #1: reserved for a Safe Swim Defense presentation and Opening Ceremony
- Evening #2: reserved for Scout Trivia and Minute-It-to-Win-It style games. For anybody interested, a Night Hike and Stargazing will also be available
- Evening #3: reserved for a Scout Skills Relay Race Challenge & a S'Mores Celebration

Meal Planning

- Allergy safe and dietary restricted meal options will be made available
- All Breakfasts and Dinners will be in the Dining Hall
- Lunches will be Grab 'n Go style to allow Scouts to eat outdoors or under pavilions
- During the Scout Siesta period, Unit Leaders will have a meeting while camp staff will help manage game stations for Scouts (i.e. volleyball, human foosball, cornhole, etc)

2024 Cub Scout Day Camp Pricing:

- Youth Scouts
 - If paid by 1/31/24: \$50.00 per day
 - If paid by 5/1/24: \$52.00 per day
 - If paid by 6/1/24: \$64.00 per day
 - If paid on 6/2/24 or later: \$69.00 per day
- Youth Scouts sibling discount (approx 10%)
 - If paid by 1/31/24: \$45.00 per day
 - If paid by 5/1/24: \$46.00 per day
 - If paid by 6/1/24: \$58.00 per day
 - If paid on 6/2/24 or later: \$62.00 per day
- Adult Participants
 - \$10.00 per day regardless of when paid
 - Reminder: Lion and Tiger Scouts must be accompanied by an adult
- You may register for as many days that you wish to attend regardless of which days they are to accommodate busy schedules. If interested in combining Day Camp with an overnight camping option, please refer to the Cub Scout Family Camp details.

- Youth Scouts (fee includes dinner and breakfast for 1 youth AND 1 adult)
 - If paid by 1/31/24: \$32.00 per night
 - If paid by 5/1/24: \$33.00 per night
 - If paid by 6/1/24: \$33.00 per night
 - If paid on 6/2/24 or later: \$46.00 per night
- Additional Youth sibling discount (approx 10%)
 - If paid by 1/31/24: \$29.00 per night
 - If paid by 5/1/24: \$30.00 per night
 - If paid by 6/1/24: \$30.00 per night
 - If paid on 6/2/24 or later: \$42.00 per night
- Extra Adult Participants (includes dinner and breakfast)
 - \$20.00 per night regardless of when paid
