Celebrating Our Camp and Council

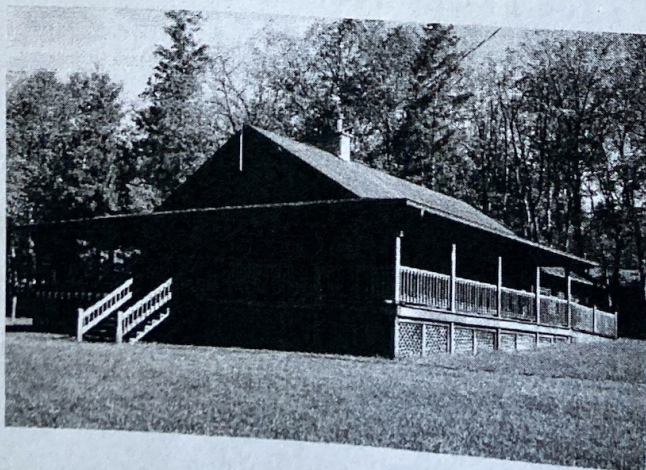

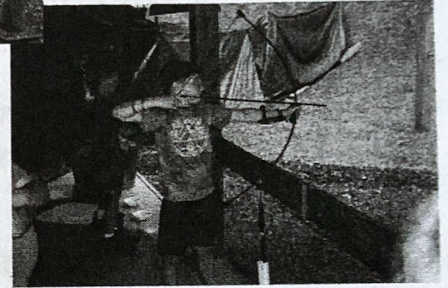


Cub Scout Day Camp

The Order of the Arrow is part of the experience of summer camp at 7MC. This year, Monaken Lodge is going to be integrated into summer camp in three BIG ways.

The first way is we will have a resident Camp Chief as a member of the staff. They will be there to answer any questions about the OA and come around to your campsites to check in (bearing gifts of course).

The second way, Wednesdays will be declared "OA Day". All Arrowmen will be encouraged to wear their sashes at breakfast and dinner and to an outdoor block party. It will be a several hour program after Wednesday's dinner that will include yard games (corn hole, horse shoes, ladder golf, etc.), an opportunity to join in Drum demonstration, Gaga Ball, and a Lodge memorabilia display. All activities will be hosted by Arrowmen to ensure participants can get any help and to keep things fun. Immediately following the party will be an ice cream social for Arrowmen to bond in Brotherhood.

The third way may be no surprise to many of you, we will have our regular Callout ceremonies for both Ordeal and Vigil Candidates. As a reminder, Vigil Callout will only happen the second week.

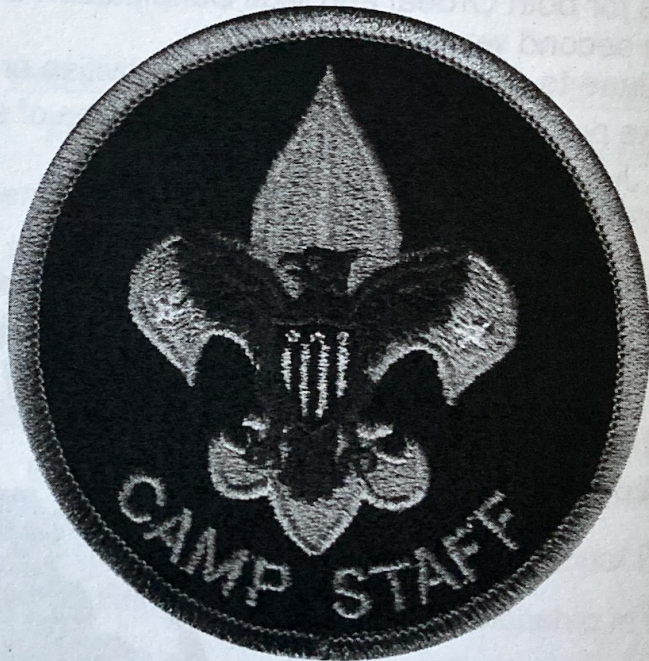

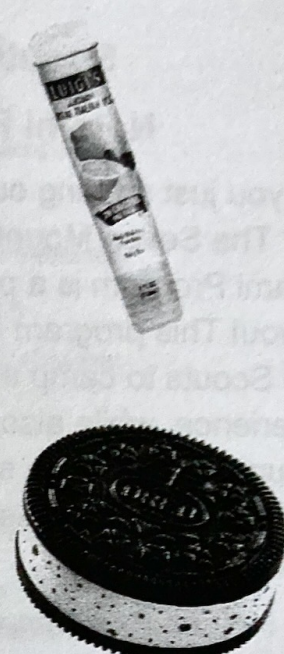

Netami Program

Are you just starting out on your Trail to Eagle? The Seven Mountains Scout Camp Netami Program is a perfect program just for you! This program is designed to orient new Scouts to camp and provide a camping experience, while also giving them an opportunity to learn the skills needed for Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class ranks.

The Netami Program will be offered throughout the Merit Badge instruction time during the day. This allows the new Scouts the time to work on their advancements, and allows them the time to be involved with their troops and other camp-wide activities.

The Patrol and Troop methods are a key building block to a successful Scout Program, so we run our Netami Program just like a Troop. When you and your Troop arrive to camp you will meet our Netami Scoutmaster who you will work with throughout the week. They will be your guide and help you and the other Scouts form Patrols that will work together and have fun throughout the week.

Volunteer Staff

The Volunteer Staff at Seven Mountains Scout Camp are some of the most important members of our staff. From our Camp Commissioner to Program Area Directors to Counselors in Training (CITs), volunteers really help us bring the camp experience to a whole new level.

Who is eligible? Any Scout or Scouter 14 years old or older are always welcome to join us at Seven Mountains Scout Camp.

Cub Scout Day, Webelos, and Scouts BSA Summer Camps Refund Policy

Approved October 24, 2007

1. All requests must be made in writing and received by the Juniata Valley Council Service Center at least two weeks prior to the start of the camp.
2. Any last minute refunds will only be given for extenuating circumstances (i.e. death in the family, major illness).
3. Refunds will not be given for a change of mind, vacation plans, summer school, extended sport schedules, or no shows.
4. Refunds will not be given once the session of camp has begun.
5. Fees may be transferred from one Scout to another within the same unit.
6. Because many expenses occur 6 weeks prior to the start of camp, the Juniata Valley Council reserves the right to withhold an administrative fee as follows:
 - A. Webelos or Scouts BSA Summer Camp = \$75.00 per person for any refund given
 - B. Cub Scout Day = \$ 25.00 per person for any refund given

Any refund will be issued by check, normally within two weeks of the request and made payable to the name listed on the receipt.

I can't go to Summer Camp with my Troop or Crew, can I still attend?

Absolutely! It is great for Scouts to attend camp with their Troop or Crew, but sometimes sports, extracurricular activities and vacations make that difficult. We also understand that units attend High Adventure Base Camps and Out of Council summer camp programs but not all scouts can make it; and sometimes scouts enjoy Summer Camp so much that they are interested in attending a second week.

If any of these pertain to you, scouts can make arrangements to come to Seven Mountains Scout Camp as a Provisional Scout and stay with another troop for the week of summer camp. Scouts should contact local troops or crews they have connections with to discuss camping with them, however if needed, you can also reach out to the camp director to help identify another Troop to connect up with.

- All adults attending must have Criminal Background Checks/Clearances as required by PA ACT 15 on file with Juniata Valley Council
- Two (2) adult leaders from each troop/crew are required for each sessions that scouts are attending per Scouting America Youth Protection Guidelines
- Additional meal tickets can be purchased at the Camp Trading Post for \$10.00 per meal.
- Unit Leaders will setup an online Group Reservation through the JVC Calendar to register individual scouts

* Individual Scouts: please contact your scoutmaster or designated summer camp unit leader first as they will coordinate individual registrations and payments for their respective units

* If preferred, online credit card payments can be processed once the initial Group Reservation is started
