
Location and Site Map

Penn's Cave and Wildlife Park is located at: 222 Penns Cave Road, Centre Hall, PA 16828

Directions: From the light at Brother's Pizza in Centre Hall, drive 4.5 miles east on PA-192 E / Church Street. Turn right onto Sara Campbell Lane and look for camporee signage.

The camporee will be held in the fenced area before the cave. Please heed the flow of traffic as one way around the grounds.

In the event of a weather emergency, the camporee committee has planned for a safe shelter for all participants and volunteers.



Facilities

Bathrooms - There are 9 portable toilets on the grounds, including 1 handicap accessible. Two hand washing stations are near the toilets.

First Aid - There will be a Paramedic on the grounds during the entire event. If you have a medical need during the weekend, please go to the designated first aid station indicated on the site map. Please note that we will be having a program involving bees.

Water Availability - There will be a freshwater tank truck in a central location for our use. Day program attendees may refill water bottles here. Units will be required to transport water from the filling station to your campsites. Other water spigots/ hydrants on the property will be locked shut.

Food - Day visitors, please bring your packed lunch as there will be no food available for purchase. Better yet, Cubs are encouraged to make plans with a troop if possible and join them for lunch at their site!

Unloading / Parking - There will be an unloading area for easier access to set up camp. After unloading, please move all vehicles to the designated parking area.

Gray Water Disposal - Troops will need to bring a bucket for hauling gray water to the designated gray water disposal tank.

Fires - Campsites may burn fires in troop-supplied raised fire pits. No ground fires are permitted. Raised cooking equipment is allowed.

Shelter - There are no tables, pavilions or canopies at campsites, please bring your own as needed.

Electricity - There are limited locations onsite to charge phones.

Trash - This is a <u>pack it in</u>, <u>pack it out</u> event. Do not leave trash bags on site, bring them home for disposal. This is an opportunity to pack lightly and consider how to minimize trash generated for the weekend.

Program Details

First and foremost, we are excited to include two tours at Penn's Cave in the pricing for all youth as well as any interested adult:

- Take a safari bus through the 1600-acre park to see wildlife such as bison, black bears, bighorn sheep, mountain lions, and wolves!
- Ride a flat-bottom motorboat through America's only all-water cavern!

Every unit must have two adults with their group on the tours.

Aside from the tours, we have other wildlife programming such as:

- A Pennsylvania Game Warden will talk about wildlife and youth will have the opportunity to build a wooden bluebird box and take it home.
- Presentations by local organizations such as the Penns Valley Conservation
 Association and PA Trappers Association
- A beekeeper will be displaying a crowd-pleasing colony of bees!
- A biologist will give a presentation on bats!
- A Mountain Man will give a presentation and start our evening campfire using primitive methods.

We will have additional engaging demonstrations and programming such as:

- Penn State Geosciences Department
- The Nittany Antique Machinery Association will have a steam engine and grist mill in operation.
- The Millheim Fire Company will be doing a demonstration and will bring Smokey the Bear.

Special just for Cub Scouts - In addition to the above, Prospector Pete's Miners Maze - a 4800 square foot labyrinth with twists and turns! According to Penn's Cave, "Getting lost has never been such fun!"
