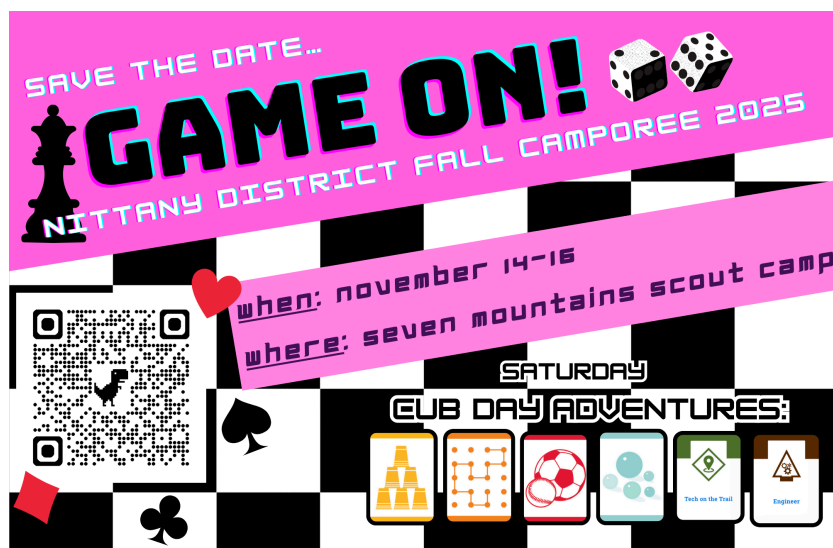


Game On! Nittany Mountain District Fall Camporee 2025

Info for Cub Scout Packs

updated 8/8/25



Troop 31 invites all troops, crews and packs to **Game On!** at the **2025 Nittany Mountain District Fall Camporee**. Theme activities will center on a mix of lawn, field, card, and board games, as well as a traditional campfire program. Cub Day (Saturday-only) registration includes activities, supplies, closing campfire with s'mores, and commemorative patch while supplies last. Weekend registration includes activities, supplies, campsite, Friday leader/PLC cracker barrel, and commemorative patch while supplies last.

When: November 14-16, 2025 (Cub Day: Saturday, Nov. 15)

Where: Seven Mountains Scout Camp, 227 Sand Mountain Road, Spring Mills, PA 16875

Cost:

- Cub Day only
 - Youth - \$5 through 10/5; \$10 10/6-10/26; \$15 10/27-11/7
 - Adults - \$5 with patch; no cost without
- Weekend (cabin rental not included)
 - Youth - \$15 through 10/5; \$20 10/6-10/26; \$25 10/27-11/7
 - Adults - \$15

Cub Day participants are encouraged to **pack a lunch** or **partner with a troop or crew** for meals.

Per current Scouting America policy, Lions through Webelos (grades K-4) may only participate in designated Cub Day activities.

AOL scouts only (grade 5) may participate in all camporee activities as individuals with a Scouts BSA troop they intend to join if coordinated with the troop in advance OR with their AOL den/patrol (see further details below).

Cub Day will include some communal activities, as well as elective adventures for all levels:

- Lion - Build It Up, Knock It Down
- Tiger - Tiger-iffic!
- Wolf - Paws of Skill
- Bear - Marble Madness
- Webelos - Tech on the Trail
- AOL - Engineer

Cub Day will conclude with an afternoon campfire, complete with s'mores.

Camping:

- Packs may rent a cabin for overnight camping via JVC website: <https://campreservation.com/497/Camps/402>. Rental is first-come, first-served.
- Packs must follow current policies from Guide to Safe Scouting: <https://www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/gss/gss03/>
- Packs must have a BALOO-trained leader present. The first part must be completed online at my.scouting.org. JVC is offering the in-person portion of BALOO training Oct 11-12, 2025 at Seven Mountains Scout Camp: <https://scoutingevent.com/497-101396>
- At least one leader must have current Hazardous Weather training, available online at [my.scouting.org](https://www.scouting.org)
- Lion Cub Scouts and Tiger Cub Scouts must have their adult partner present to take part in overnight camping.

Arrow of Light Scouts may participate at a Scouts BSA "camporee" during the day and/or overnight in one of two ways:

- **With their Arrow of Light Den/Patrol.** Arrow of Light Scouts can attend as an Arrow of Light den/patrol under the supervision of two deep leadership from their Arrow of Light den/patrol or pack. The Arrow of Light Scout's parent or legal guardian(s) may attend with the Arrow of Light den/patrol and their child, either alongside the two-deep leadership or as part of it if they are registered with the pack. Or
- **As an Individual Scout.** Arrow of Light Scouts can attend with their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) if the local council coordinates two deep leadership per NCAP Standard HS-502. Individual AOL scouts are encouraged to participate with a Scouts BSA troop they are eligible to join.

All attending scouts and adults must have a current Scouting America Annual Health & Medical Record-Parts A & B, to be retained by the unit leader or (if scout attending individually) accompanying parent/guardian. <https://www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/ahmr/>
