

**Cooking Stations – both divisions – Clarification:**

On the use of "corn," it must be physical corn, not a derivative product, e.g corn syrup. For instance, pancake syrup made with corn syrup is not an acceptable use for the corn requirement in the station. However, it is not restricted otherwise, meaning for instance, making corn fritters and dipping in syrup is acceptable, as the fritters are made from corn kernels. Items like cornmeal is acceptable as an ingredient.

**Black Powder / Rifle – Scouts BSA Division - Change:**

Due to the fact that the council owns only two black powder rifles, we will not be able to have all participants shoot a muzzleloader. Please note that due to Scouting America regulations, we cannot use guns that are not owned by the council, we cannot accept donated use of privately owned guns. The current plan is to have all participants shoot the rifles as before. Then two team members will be chosen at random to fire a muzzleloader, To make it fairer, one will be chosen from those that scored a hit, and one from those that missed. All team members will be able to watch the two shoot.
