REGISTRATION: 4:00 PM (DINING HALL). Please have your registration forms for Troop and Patrol ready. Forms are in this packet.

THEME: This year's Fall Camporee will focus on building Activity Boards for local nursing homes. An activity board is a portable sensory tool featuring various tactile elements like switches, locks, or many other items designed to help calm the mind, improve focus, and manage stress, anxiety, or sensory overload. It is also used as a source of rehabilitation for many children and adults recovering from various health conditions.

This weekend, your patrols will be given the task of building, from scratch, an activity board. You are asked to supply switches, locks, hasps and other materials to build your Patrol's board. There will be several stations such as sanding, painting, drying, and assembling to help the patrols with the build. Work on this project will qualify you for partial credit on the Woodworking Merit Badge.

HOW TO PREPARE: Your patrols should begin to collect switches, locks, doorknobs and other maneuverable items to be attached on the board (approx 20 items per board). Plywood for the project will be provided (either 2' x 2' or 1' x 4' sides) to build the activity board.

COST: The cost is \$16.00 per scout or adult. Registration can be done either in person at the event or on the Council's Black Pug Software. To be eligible for Fall Camporee Iron Troop points, units must stay the entire weekend (Friday to Sunday). Iron Troop points will be awarded for registered unit attendance as per Iron Troop Guidelines.

There will be a Senior Patrol Leader/Adult Leader meeting Friday night at the Dining Hall. Units will be informed of the time of the meeting at registration. Please send your SPL and one (1) Adult Leader from each unit to the meeting.

A Camp Map and Directions to Camp Anderson are provided at the end of this packet.

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COVID-19 SAFETY:

This event will follow all applicable Centers For Disease Control (CDC) guidelines in effect at the time of the event.

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION:

A reminder, please use your IRON TROOP Patrol name at all activities so proper credit can be given to your patrol for attendance.

All meals will be cooked by units in-site. No meals will be provided by event staff.

Unit Leaders, on the registration form, must certify that they have Class A and Class B Medical Forms available for all youth and adults attending.

Campfires are permitted, but remember to Leave No Trace! We are asking you to bring 1 – 2 empty gallon jugs; this will be to collect water for fire safety. **All activities will go on, rain or shine, so Be Prepared.**

A time schedule will be handed out at the event with specific activity times.

PROGRAM:

ACTIVITY BOARD ASSEMBLY:



Each Patrol will be asked to create an Activity Board as described above, using switches, locks, hasps, latches, doorknobs, and other appropriate operative devices. An “appropriate operative device” is defined as one that is easily graspable, poses no pinching, stabbing, or detachment hazard, and is not covered in a material that can flake off, chip, or be otherwise ingestible, either by mouth or by respiration.

The only hardware/items that Patrols are asked to bring are the devices to be mounted on the boards. All other materials (board plywood sections, paint, hinges, screws, sandpaper, etc.) will be provided to each Patrol at the event.

This is a Patrol, and not a Unit, activity!

Assembly will be done on Saturday during the event, and Patrols may be able to finish Sunday morning, time permitting. A time schedule for when your Patrol will go through the Assembly line will be distributed at Registration.

Patrols and Units are responsible for transporting their Activity Boards from the event, and for donating them to local nursing homes or care facilities.

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OPEN RIFLE SHOOT:

Come test your Rifle skills! The Camp Anderson Rifle Range will be open Friday evening and during the day on Saturday for Open Shooting. Eye and Ear Protection will be provided individually to ALL YOUTH at the time of registration on Friday. **Come shoot under the lights on Friday night** or during the day Saturday! Open Range times will be identified at registration Friday evening. This is a first-come, first-served opportunity during the times the range is open, and Scouts are asked to be COURTEOUS at all times, which means take your turn, and leave some opportunity for the next round of shooters.

Be sure to keep and safeguard your Eye and Ear Protection for the entire weekend. It is yours to keep, but you must also take care of it! Replacements may not be available depending on the number of scouts attending!

OPEN ARCHERY SHOOT:

The Camp Anderson Archery Range will be open during the weekend. As with the Rifle Range, range times will be identified at registration Friday evening. This is also a first-come, first-served opportunity during the times the range is open, and Scouts are asked to be COURTEOUS at all times, which means take your turn, and leave some opportunity for the next round of archers!

OBSTACLE COURSE AND PIONEERING CHALLENGES:

During the day on Saturday, at a specified time to be announced at the event, an Obstacle Course Challenge and a Pioneering Challenge will be offered at the Camp.

OPEN FISHING AND GAGA BALL:

Scouts and Adults are free to fish at the lake during their free time at the event. In addition, the Camp Gaga Ball Pit by the showerhouse will be open on a first-come, first-served basis!

CAMPFIRE PROGRAM:

For the Saturday Evening campfire program, patrols must bring a skit or cheer to perform during the campfire. Skit and Cheer proposals must be turned in at the Dining Hall no later than Saturday Afternoon to ensure all content is appropriate for a Scouting Audience. The Campfire Program Order will be determined based on the number of acts received.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

FIREWOOD:

There are several options for Troops to have firewood at the Camporee. Any fires using wood that contains nails must be in established fire locations only. **NO exceptions.** Troops may cut wood from the woods from any downed tree for firewood at no cost. Follow all safety guidelines while cutting. Troops may purchase pre-cut and split wood from one of the existing stockpiles. Rate schedules are posted at the camp and online under "Other Items" at <http://campanderson.net/reservations>. Precut stockpiles are identified by being tarped, so please do not take firewood from a tarped pile unless you arrange to pay for it. You may bring your own firewood with you to camp.

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VEHICLES IN CAMP:

Please do not drive any vehicles into an area that is taped off.

TRADING POST:

There will be a trading post at the Camporee with pre-packaged snacks only.

TICK SAFETY:

Please be aware that you also need to watch for ticks, and perform a self-check as often as possible during the weekend.

The most important thing about this weekend is to safely **HAVE FUN!**

FROM DUNCANSVILLE/HOLLIDAYSBURG/ALTOONA:

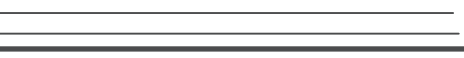
Get on Interstate 99 North to the Bald Eagle Exit. Take the Bald Eagle Exit and make a left off the exit, and travel down to the stoplight. Make a left at the stoplight onto South Eagle Valley Road ("Old" Route 220), and proceed approximately 1 mile to VanScoyoc Hollow Road. There is a sign at the intersection. Make a RIGHT onto VanScoyoc Hollow Road, and proceed approximately 2.2 miles to Camp Anderson. The driveway will be on your left.

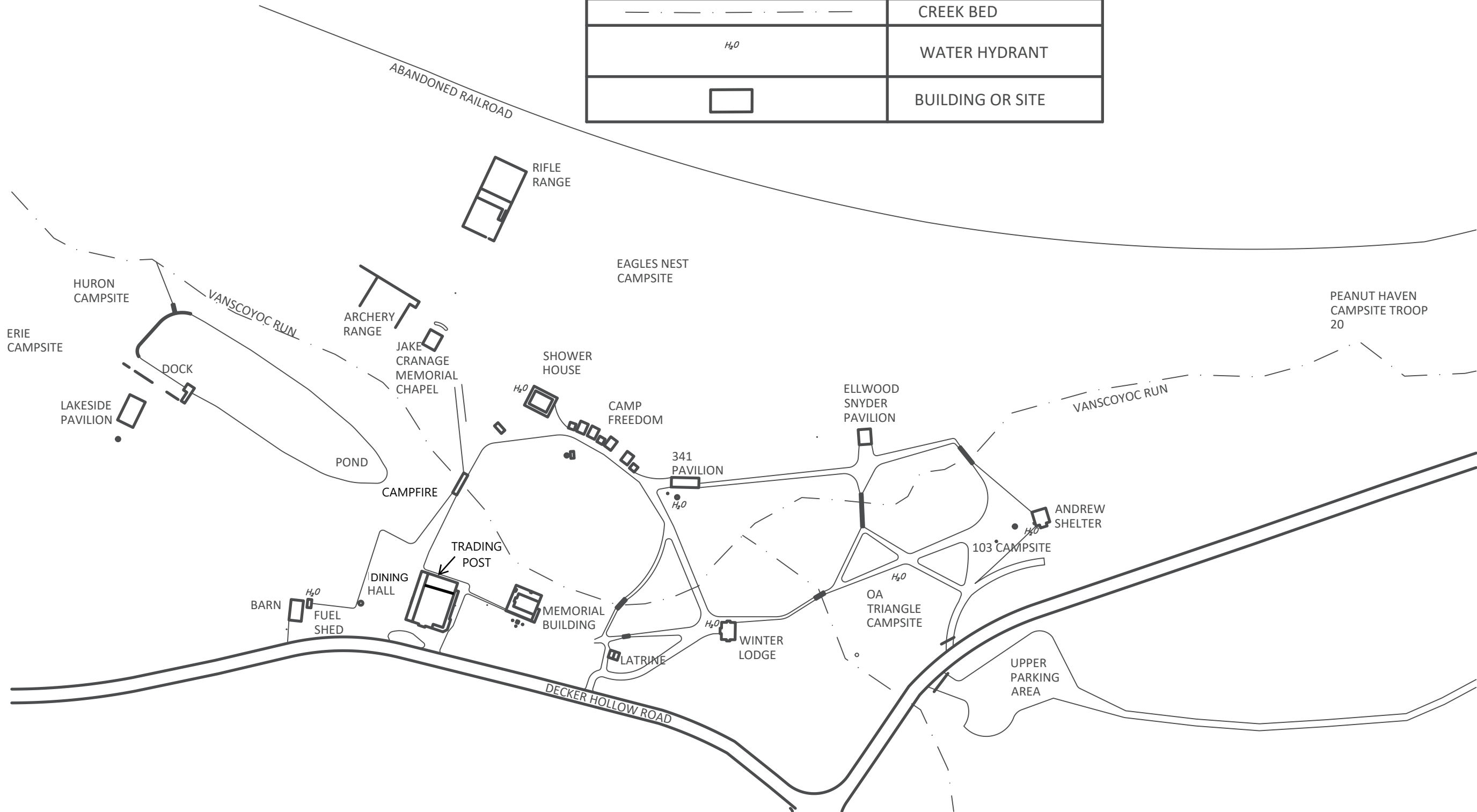


FROM STATE COLLEGE AND POINTS NORTH:

Get on Interstate 99 South to the Bald Eagle Exit. Take the Bald Eagle Exit and make right off the exit, and travel down to the stoplight. Make a left at the stoplight onto South Eagle Valley Road ("Old" Route 220), and proceed approximately 1 mile to VanScoyoc Hollow Road. There is a sign at the intersection. Make a LEFT onto VanScoyoc Hollow Road, and proceed approximately 2.2 miles to Camp Anderson. The driveway will be on your left.
